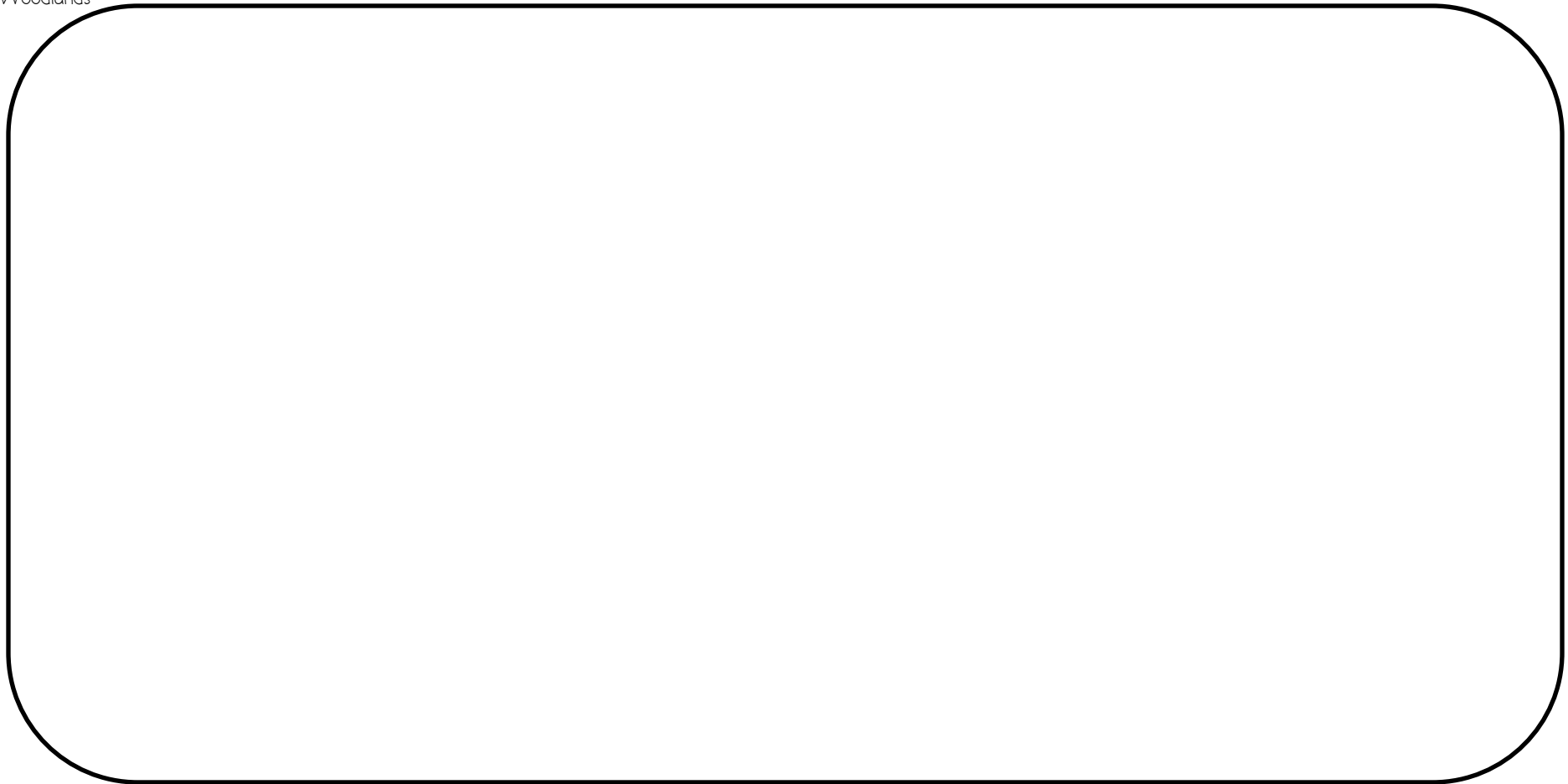




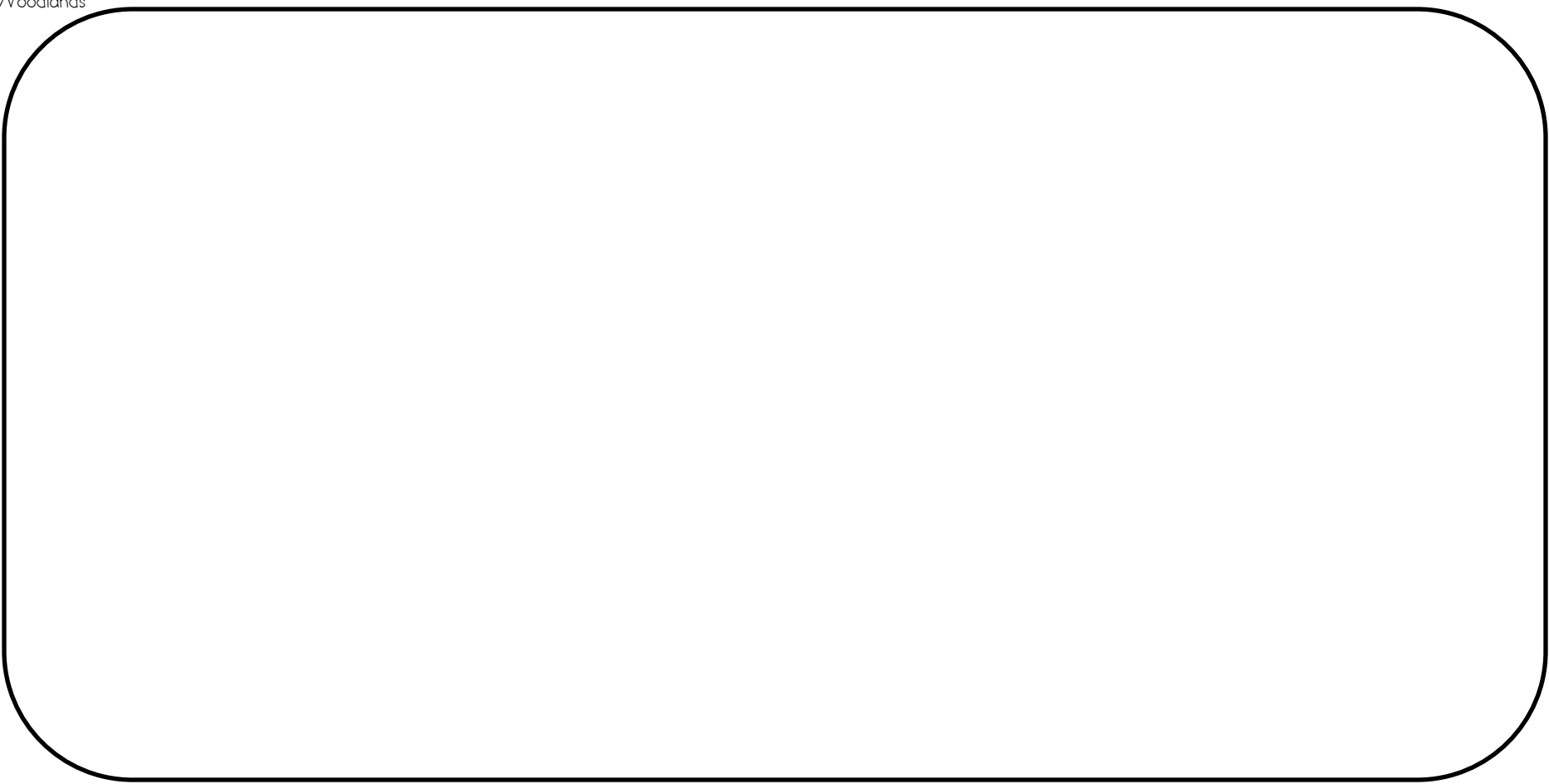
The ground is land. Plants

need land.



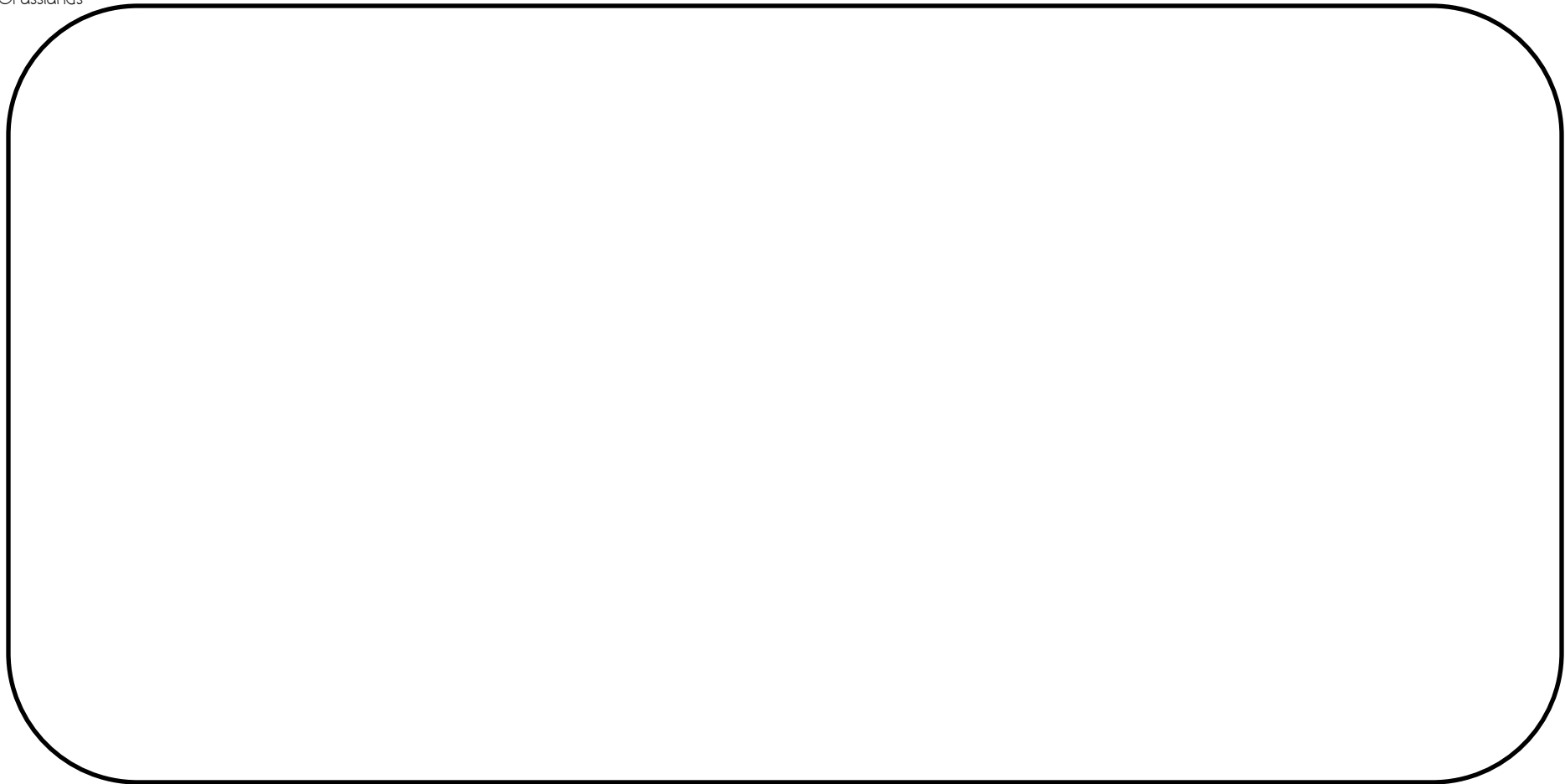

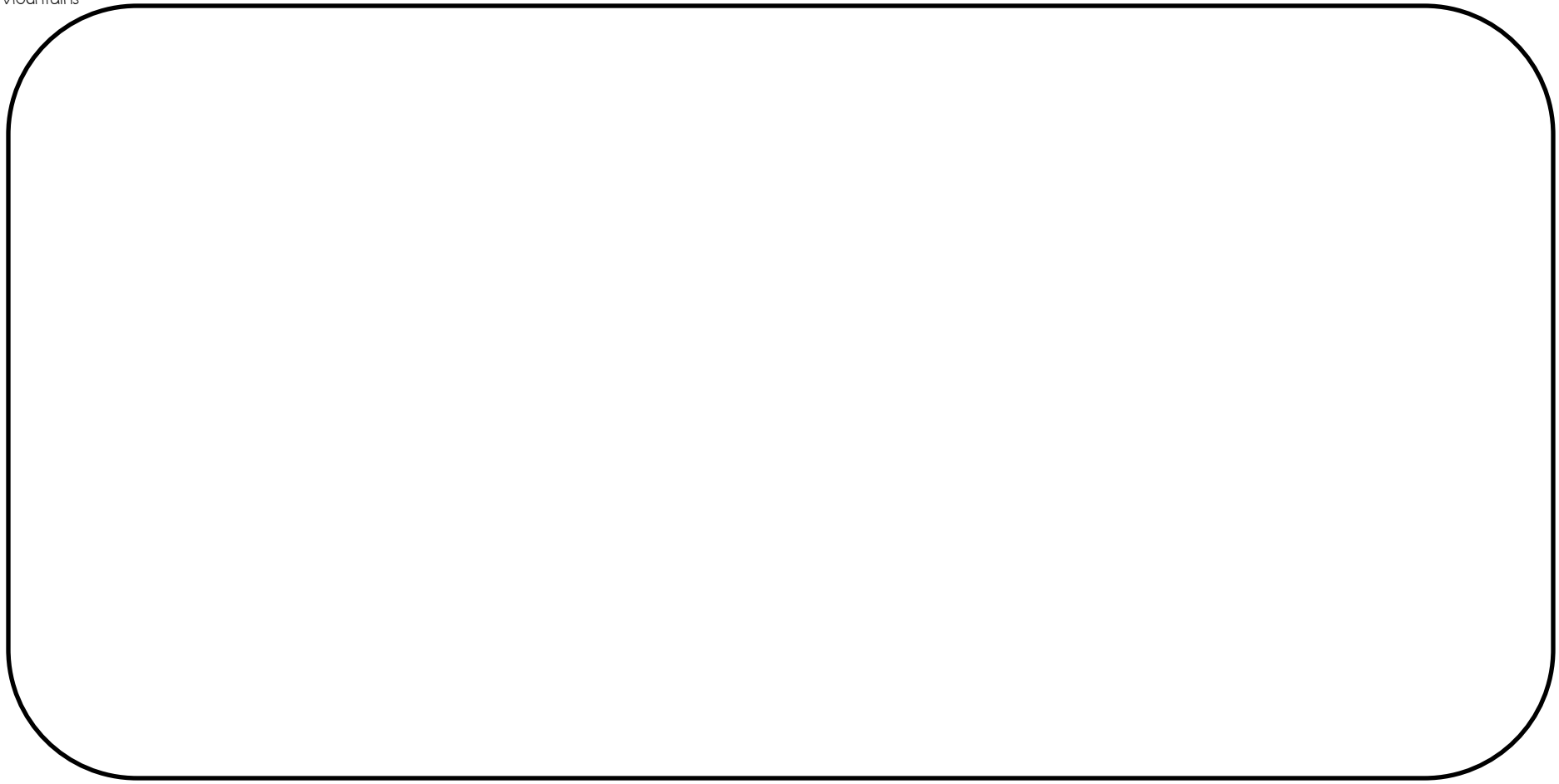

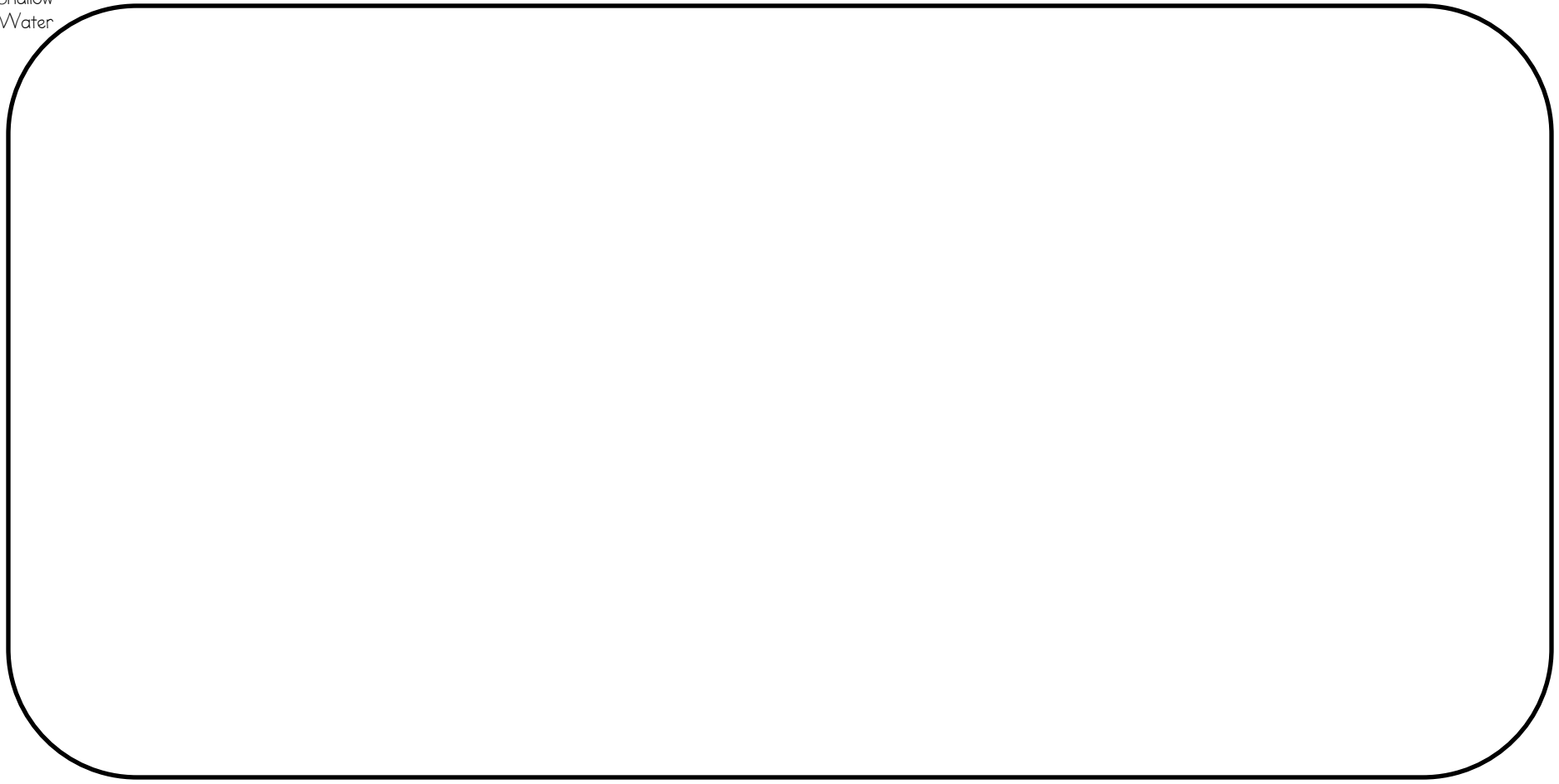

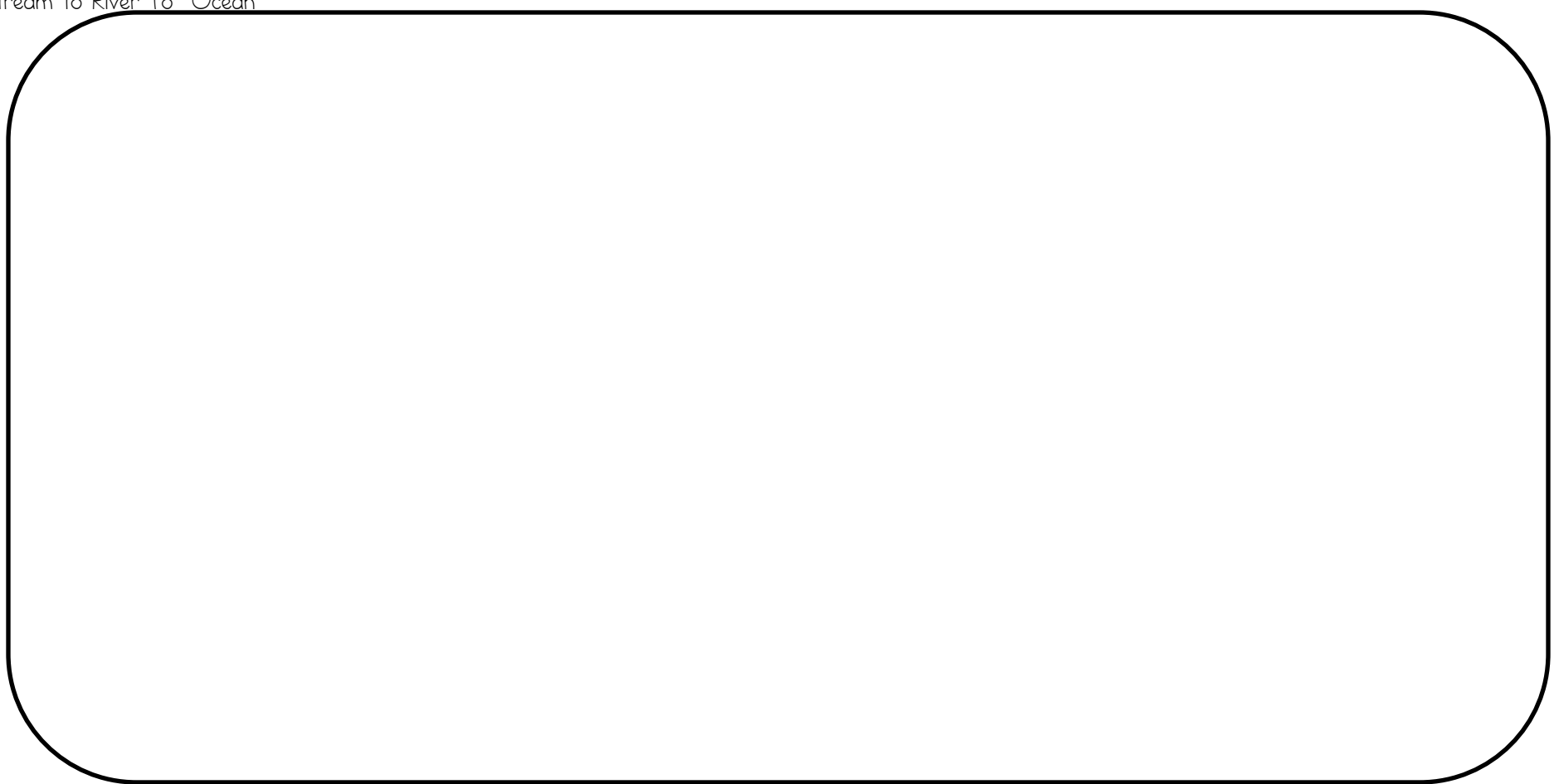

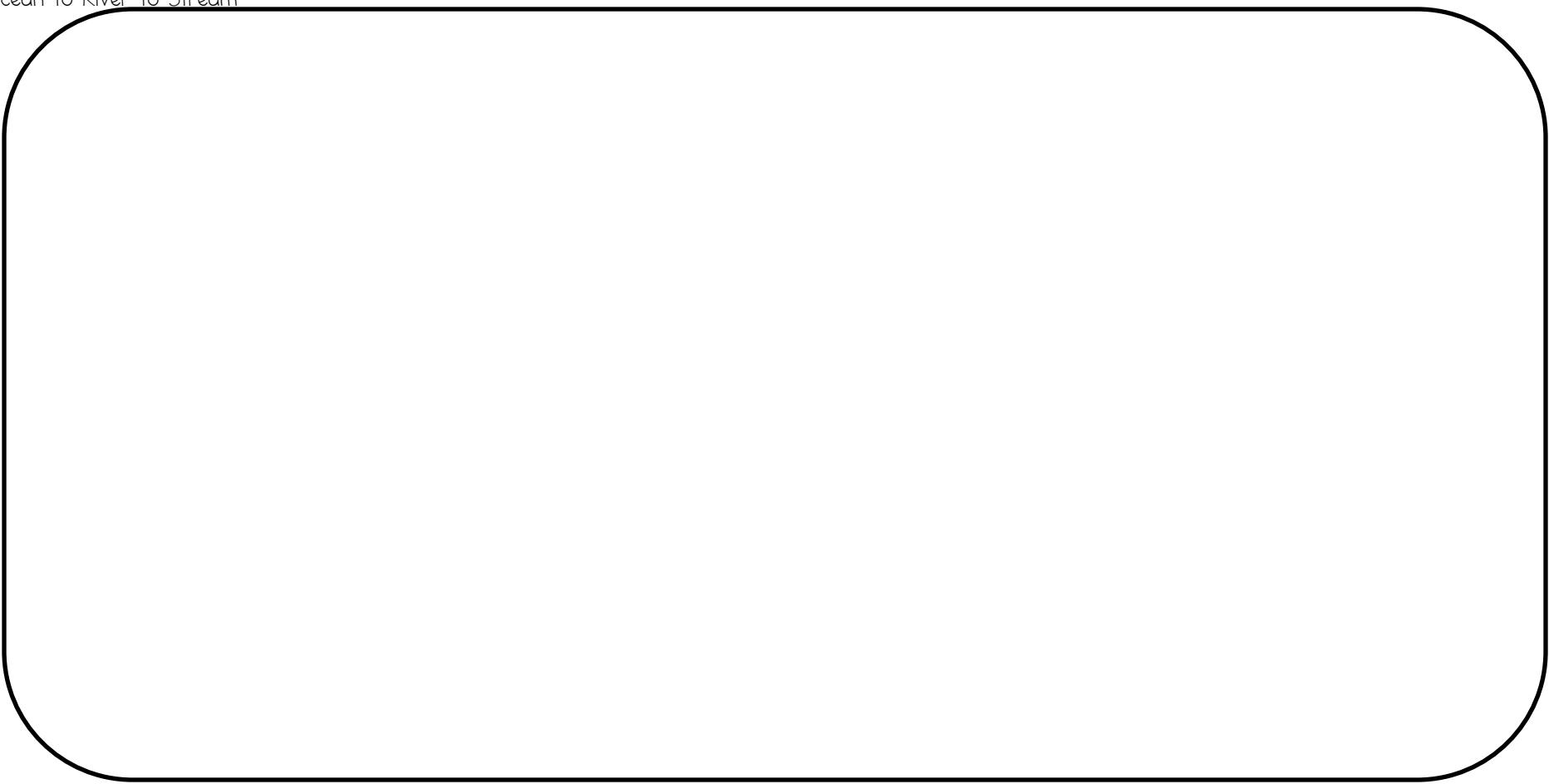
Most rivers flow to oceans. Salmon

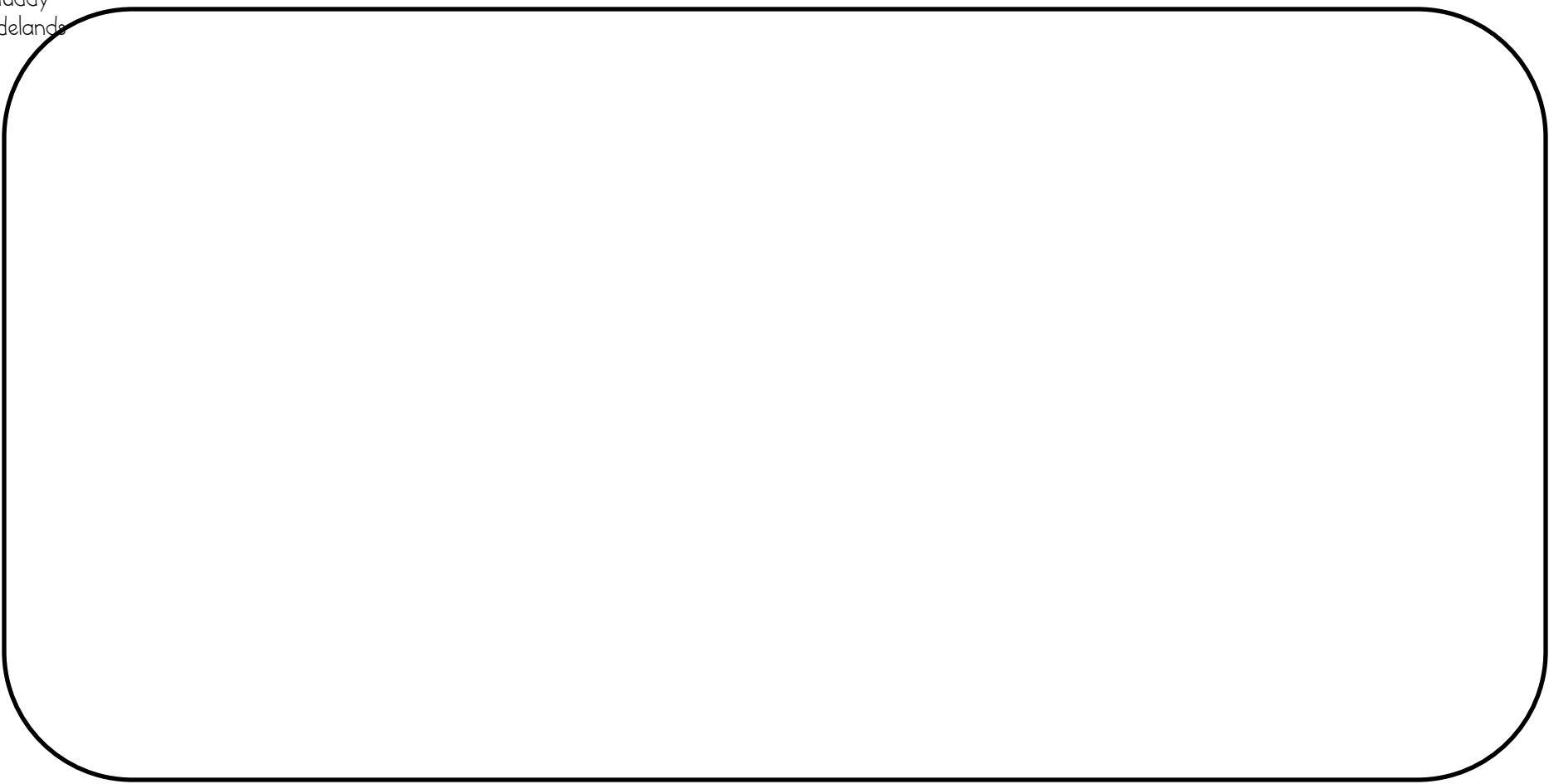

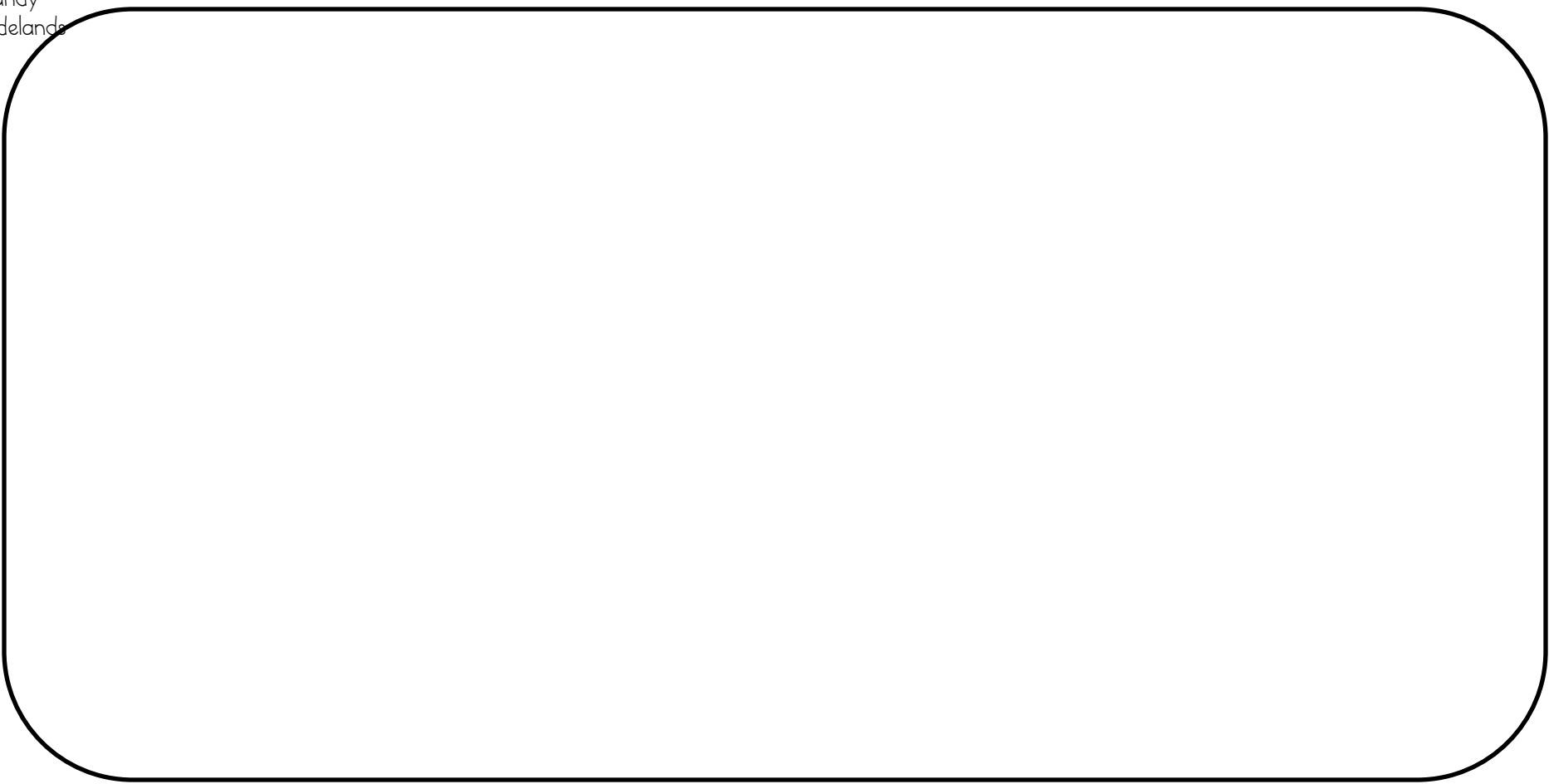

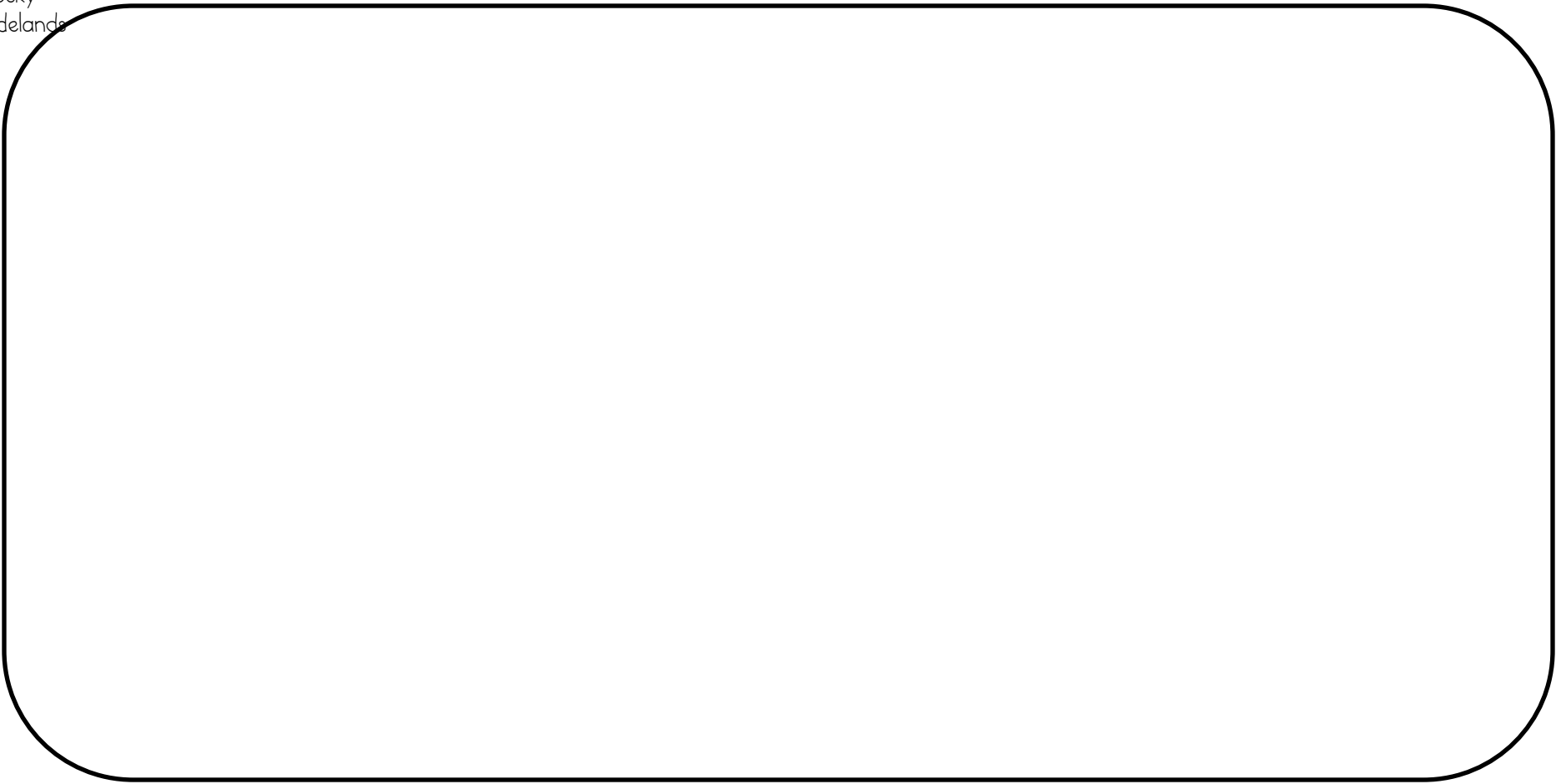

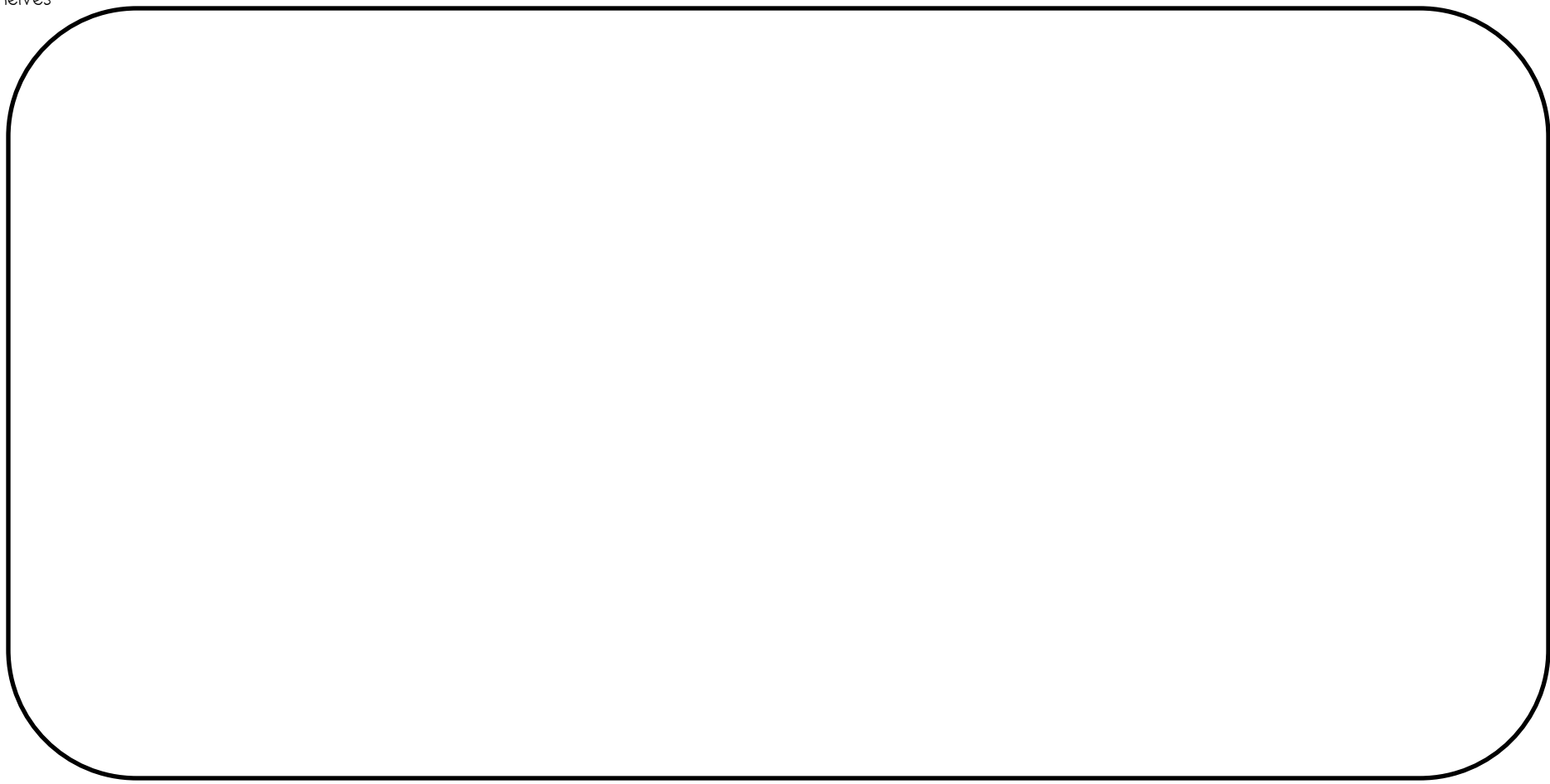

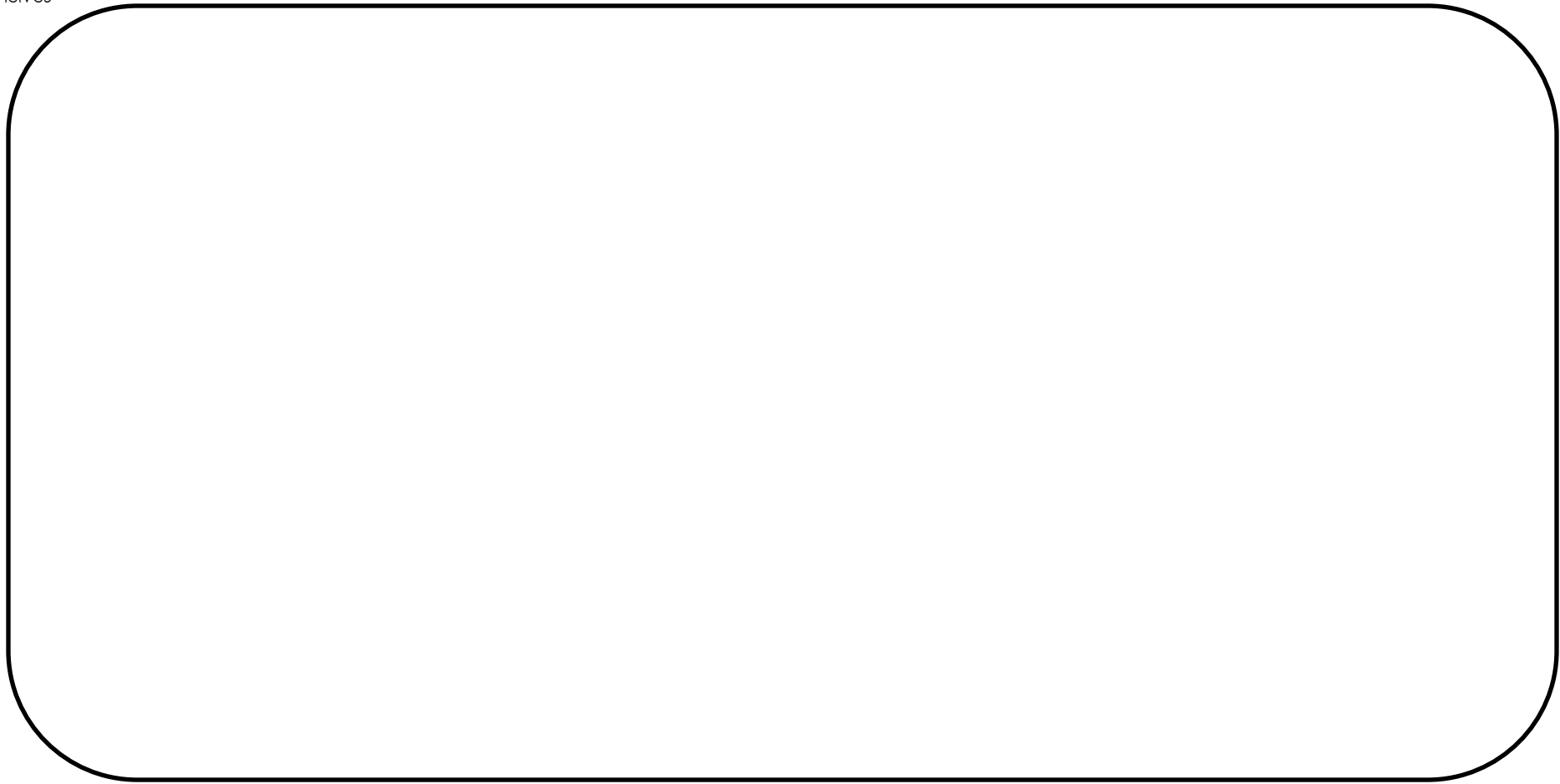

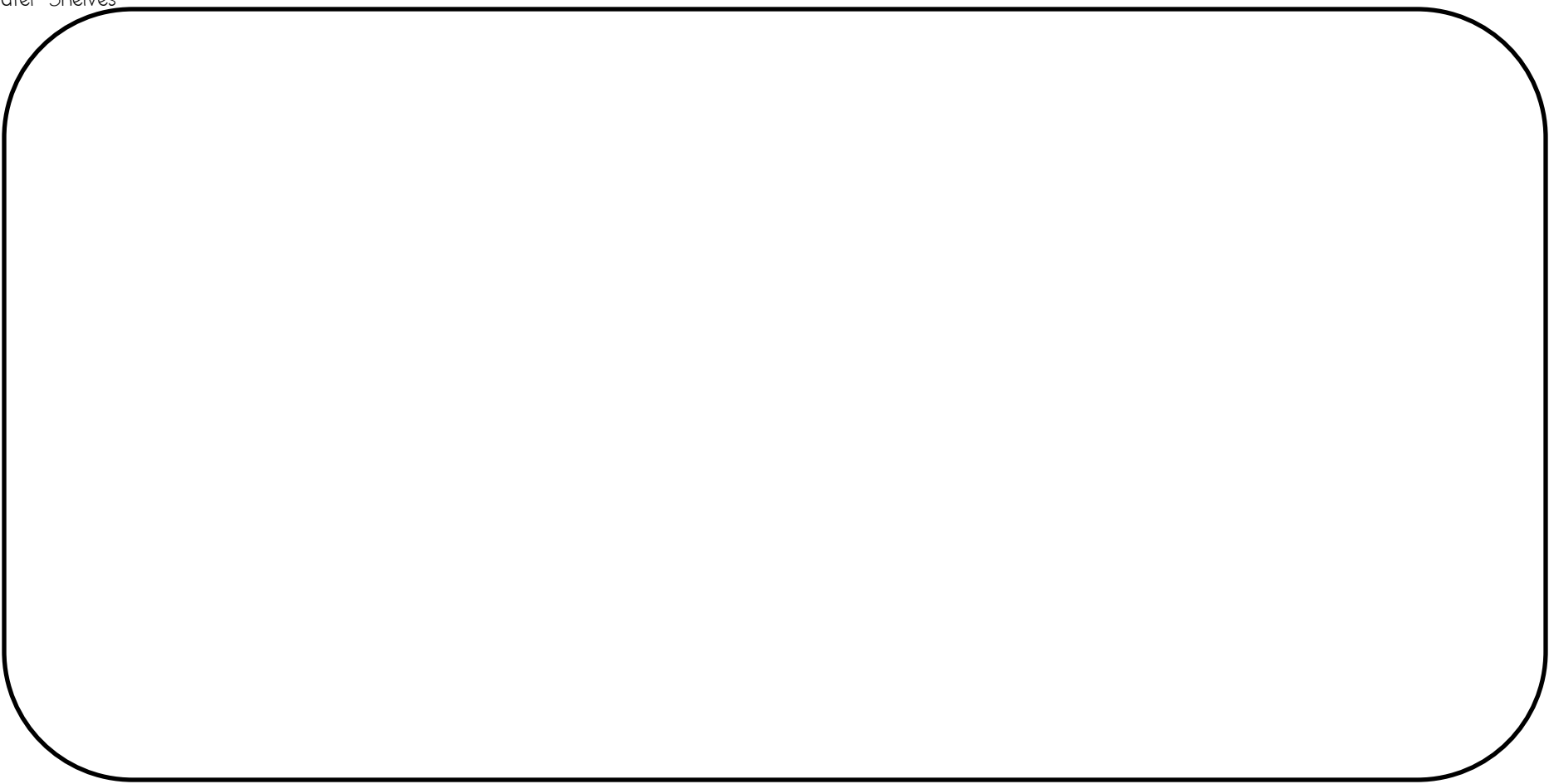

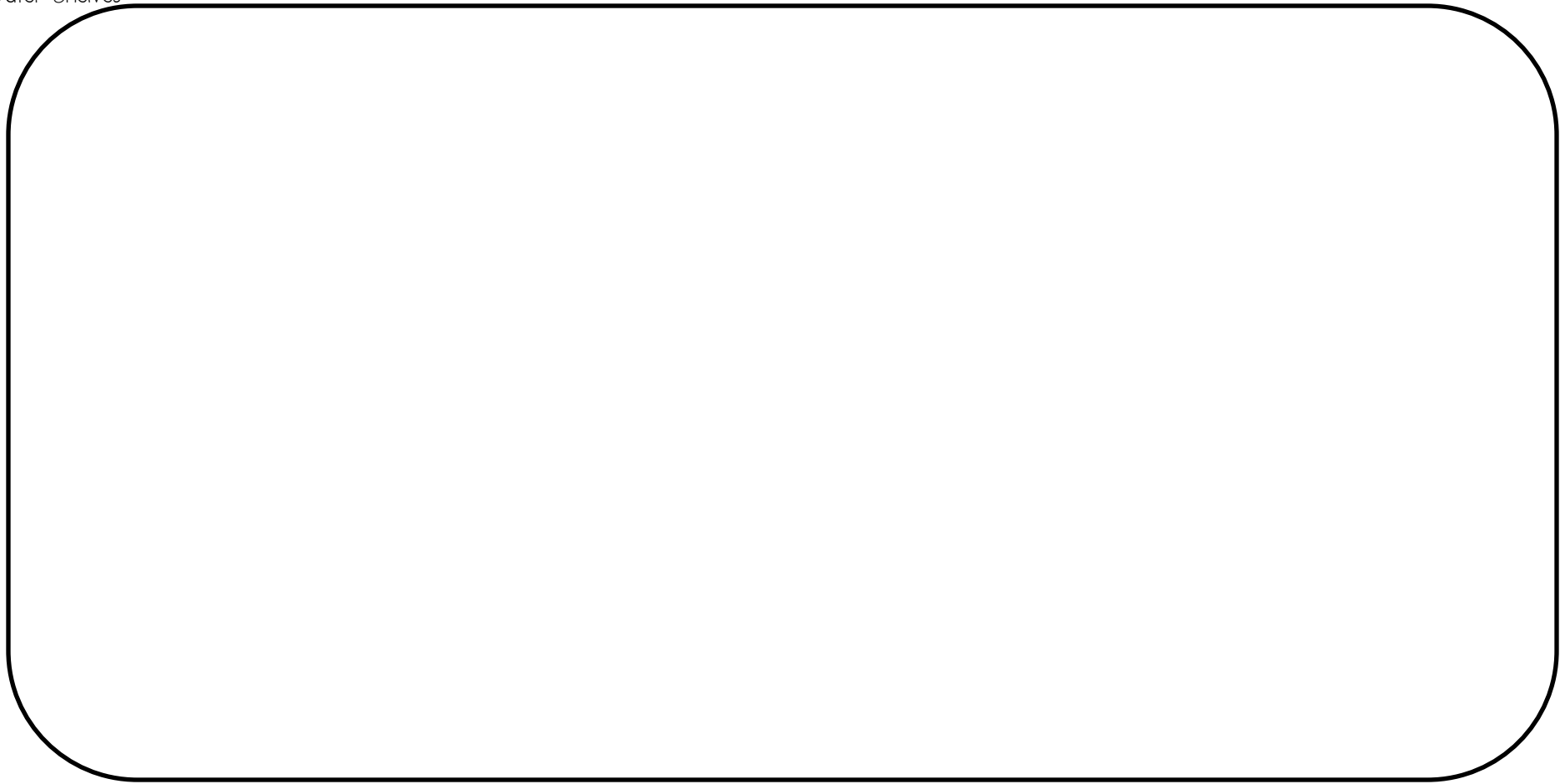

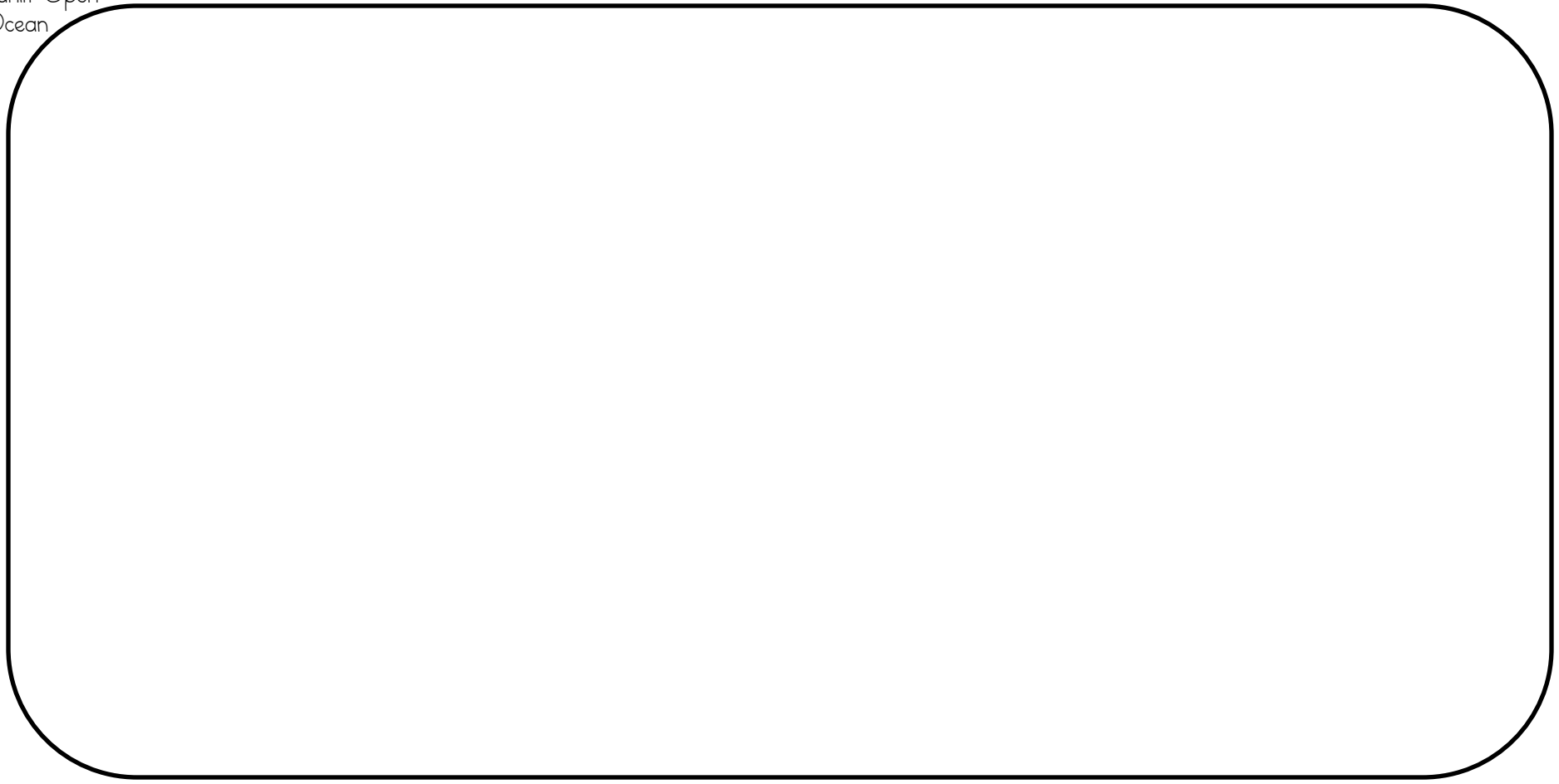

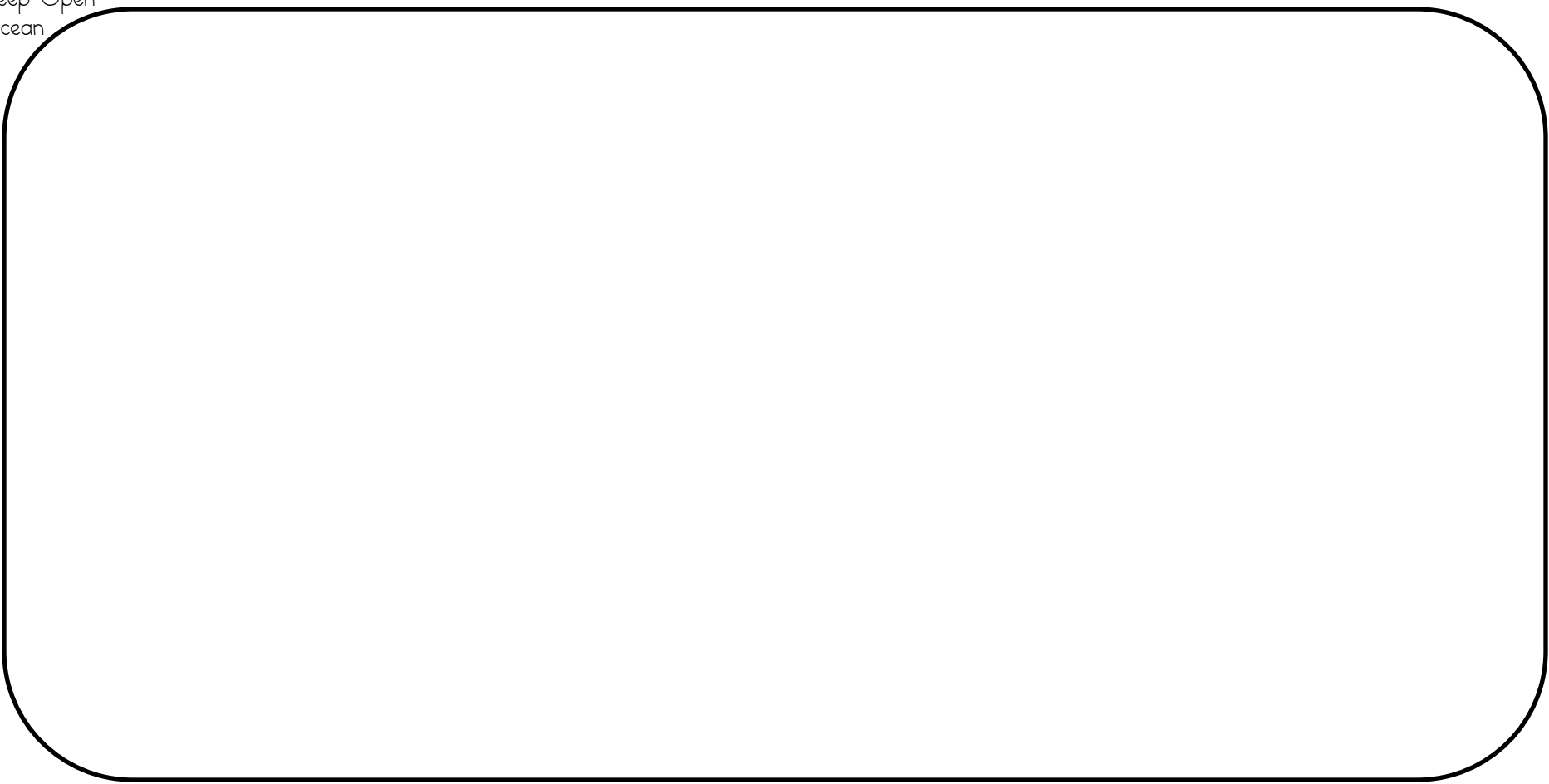
