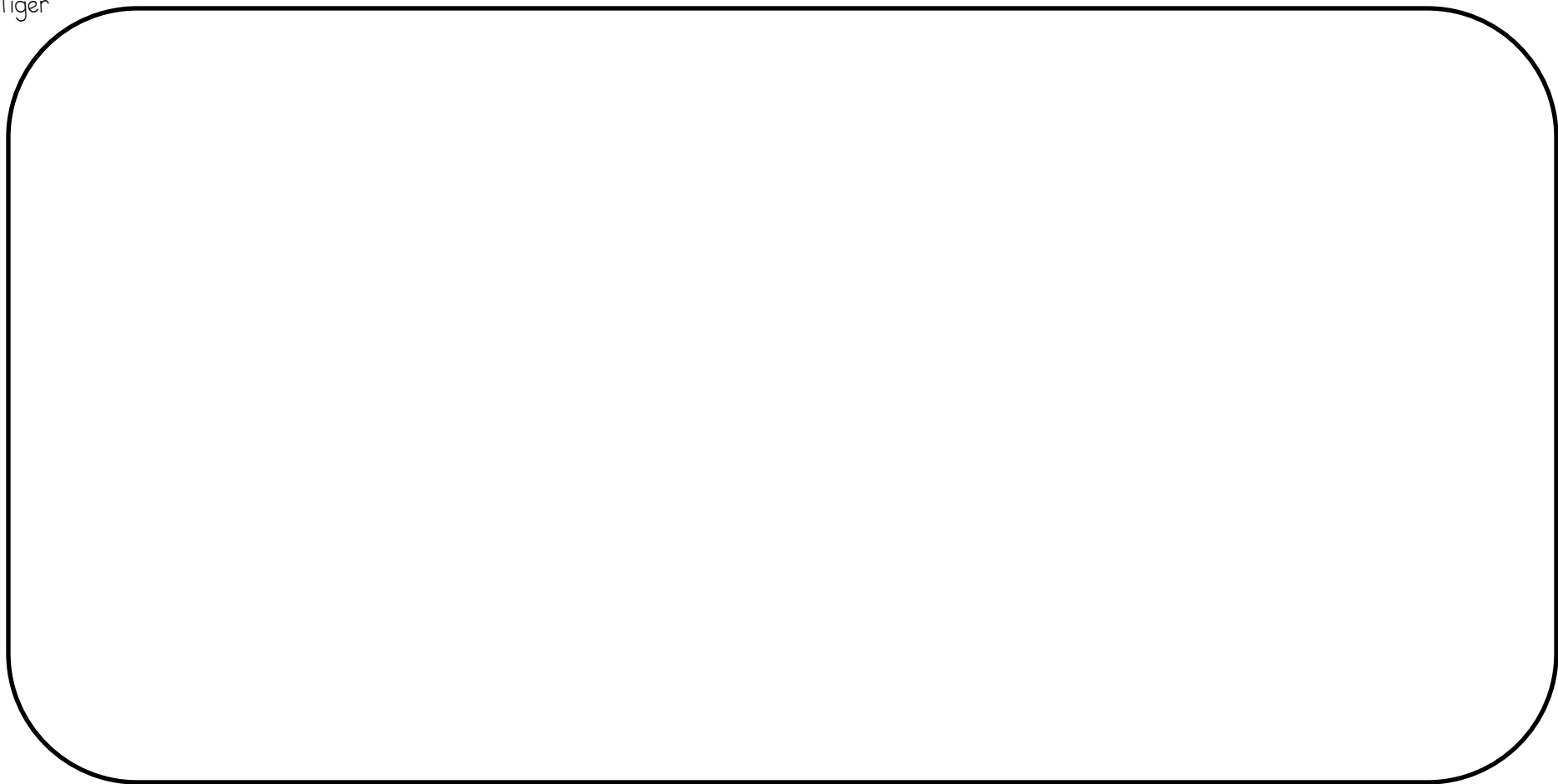
Asian elephants are huge. They

to carry things.



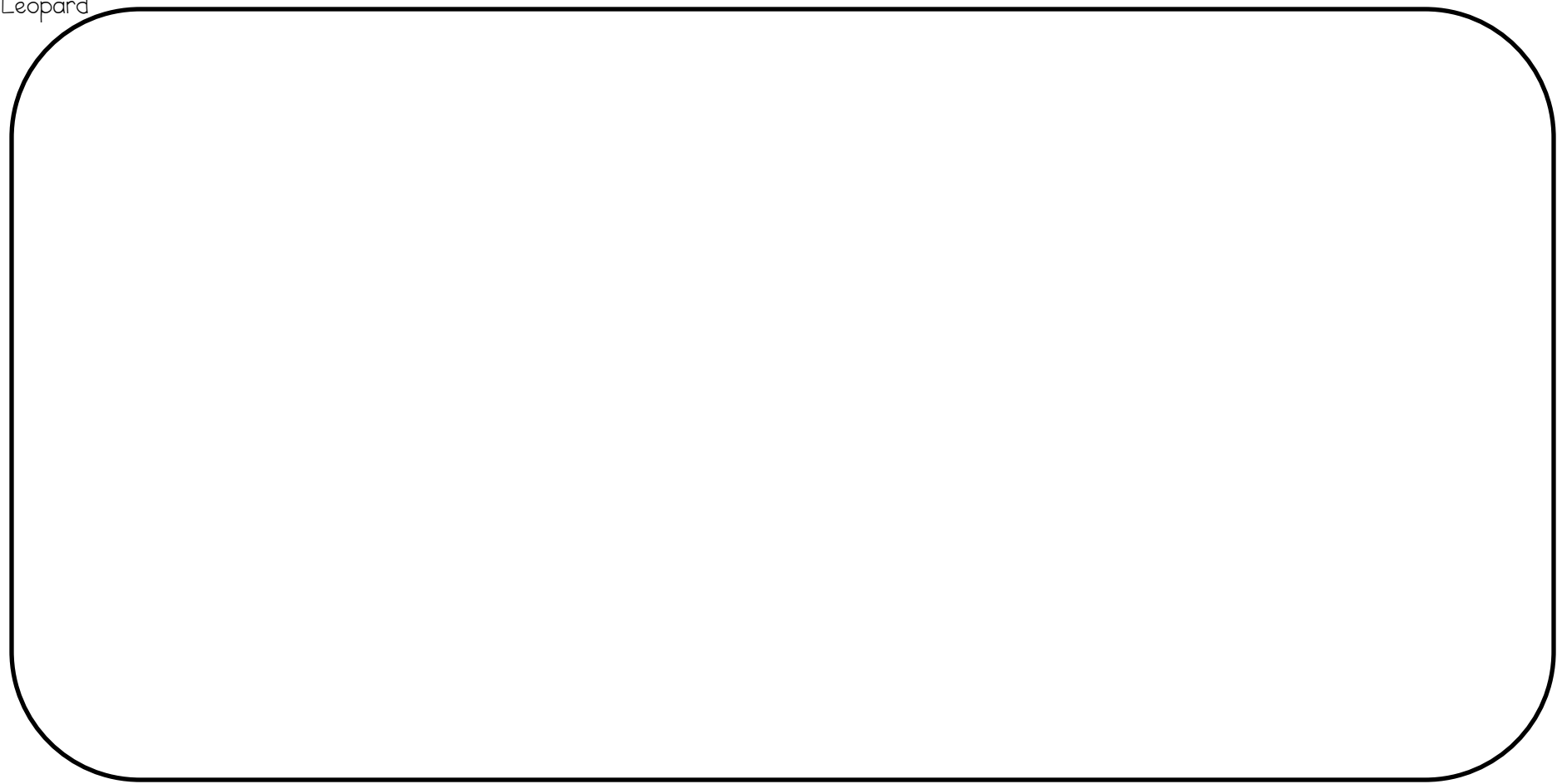

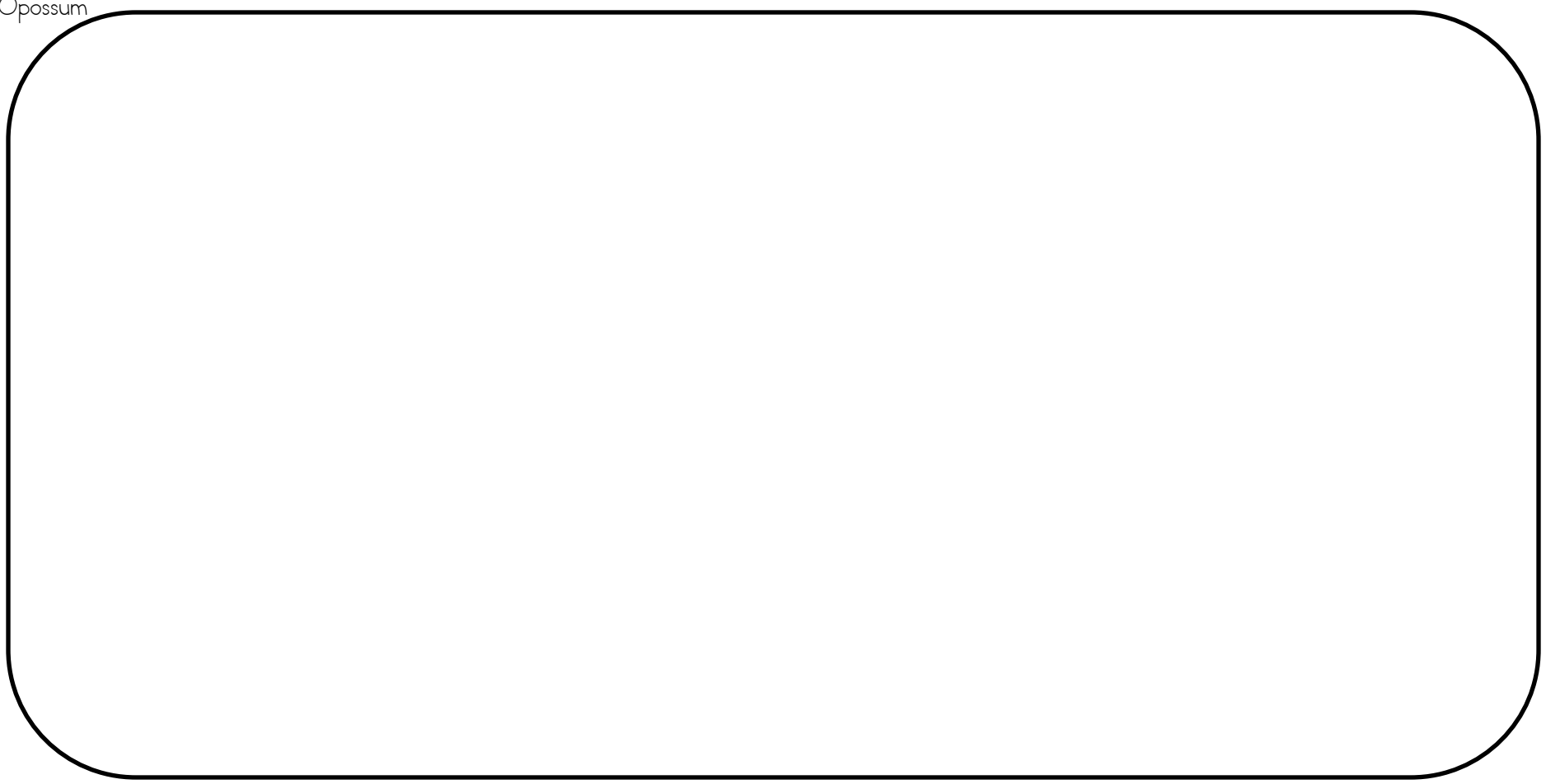

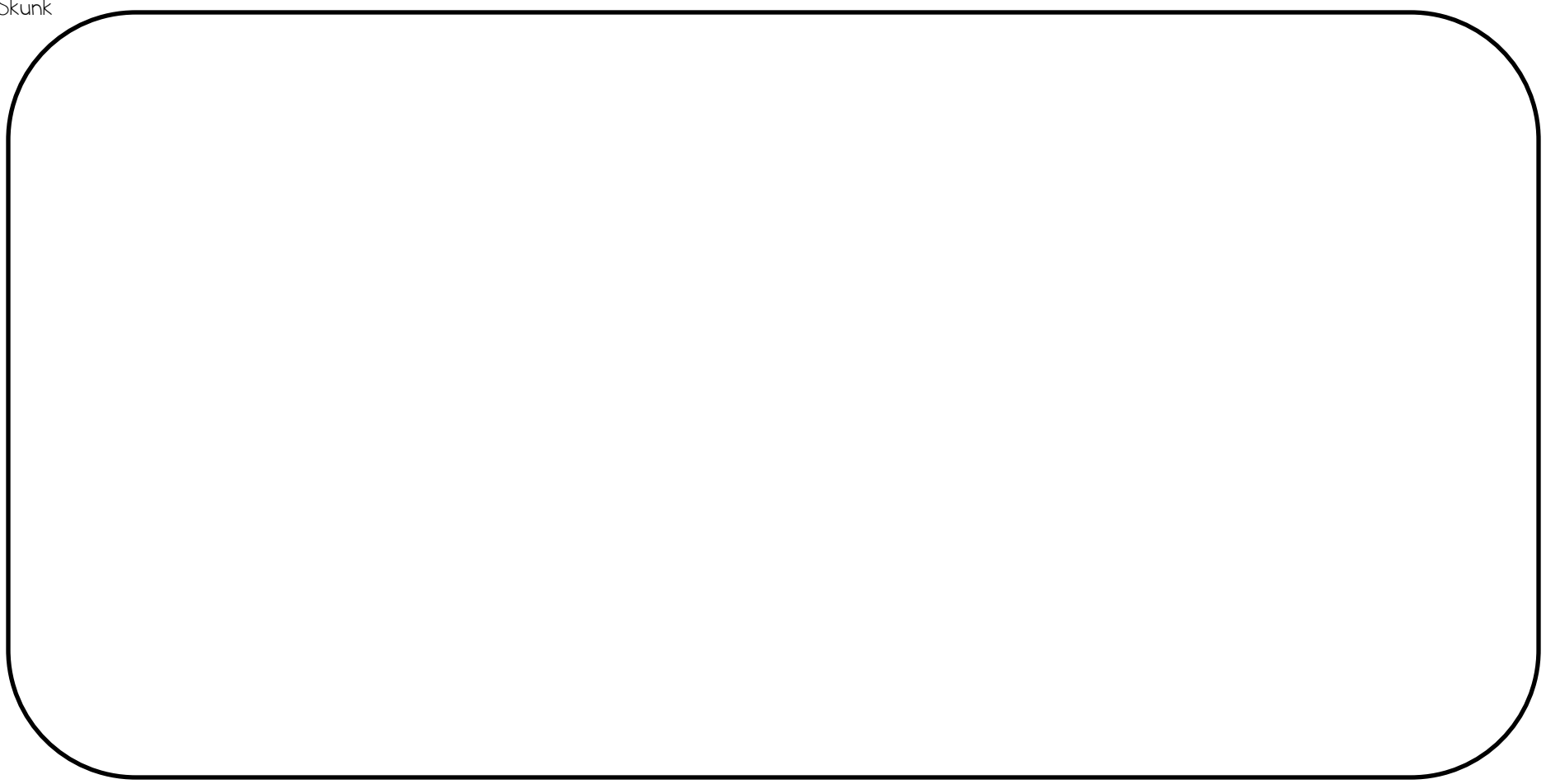

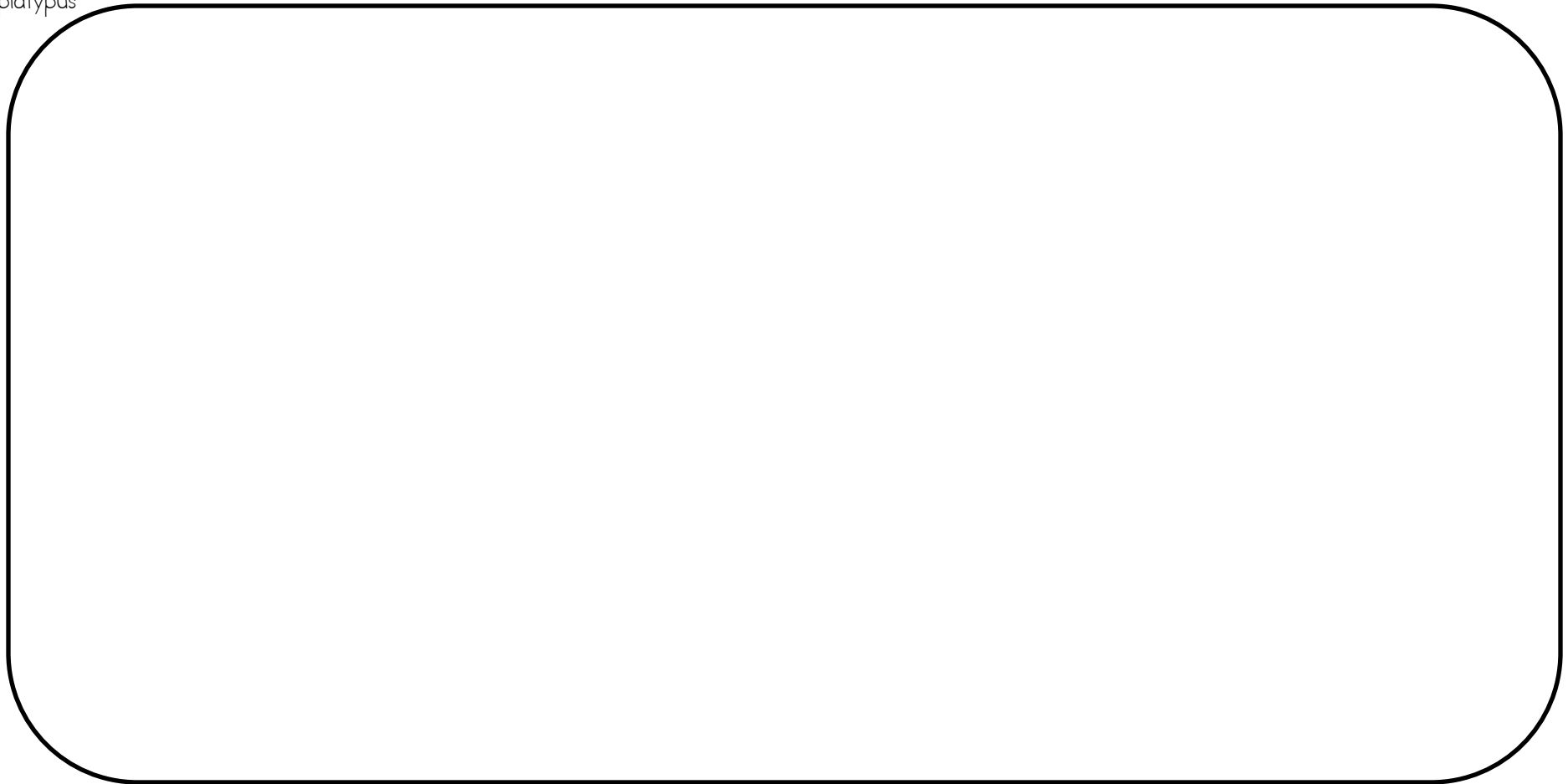

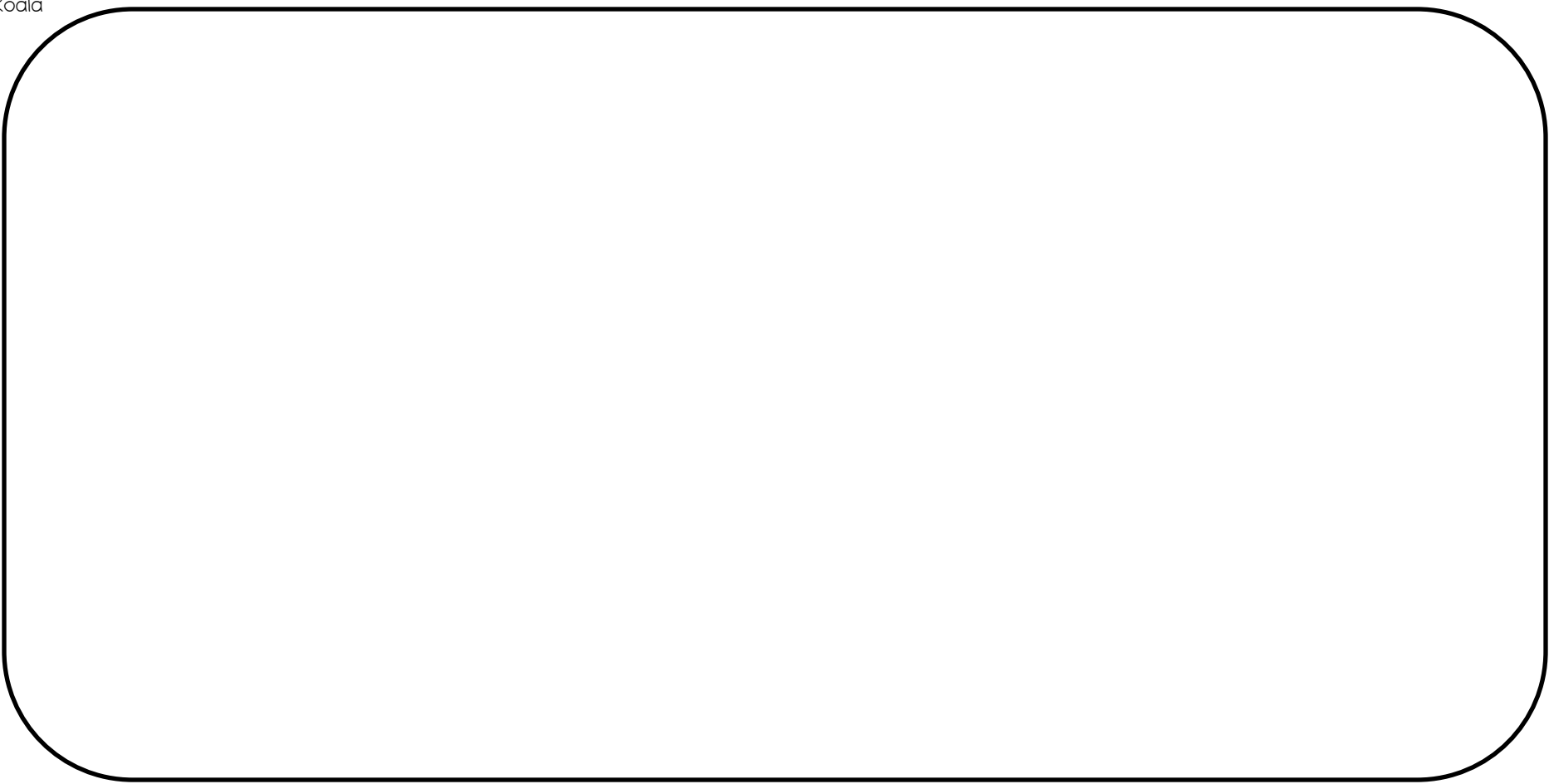

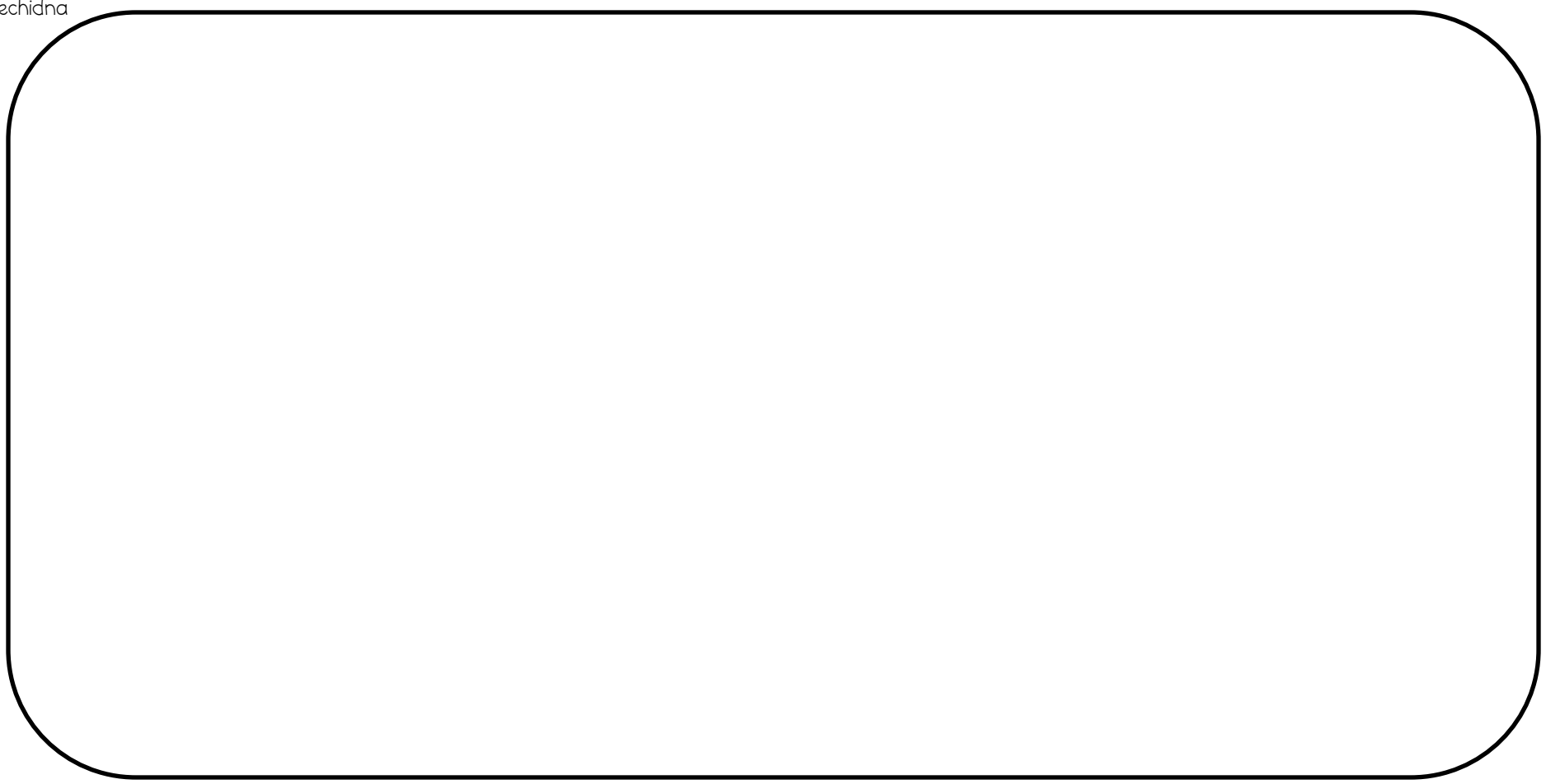

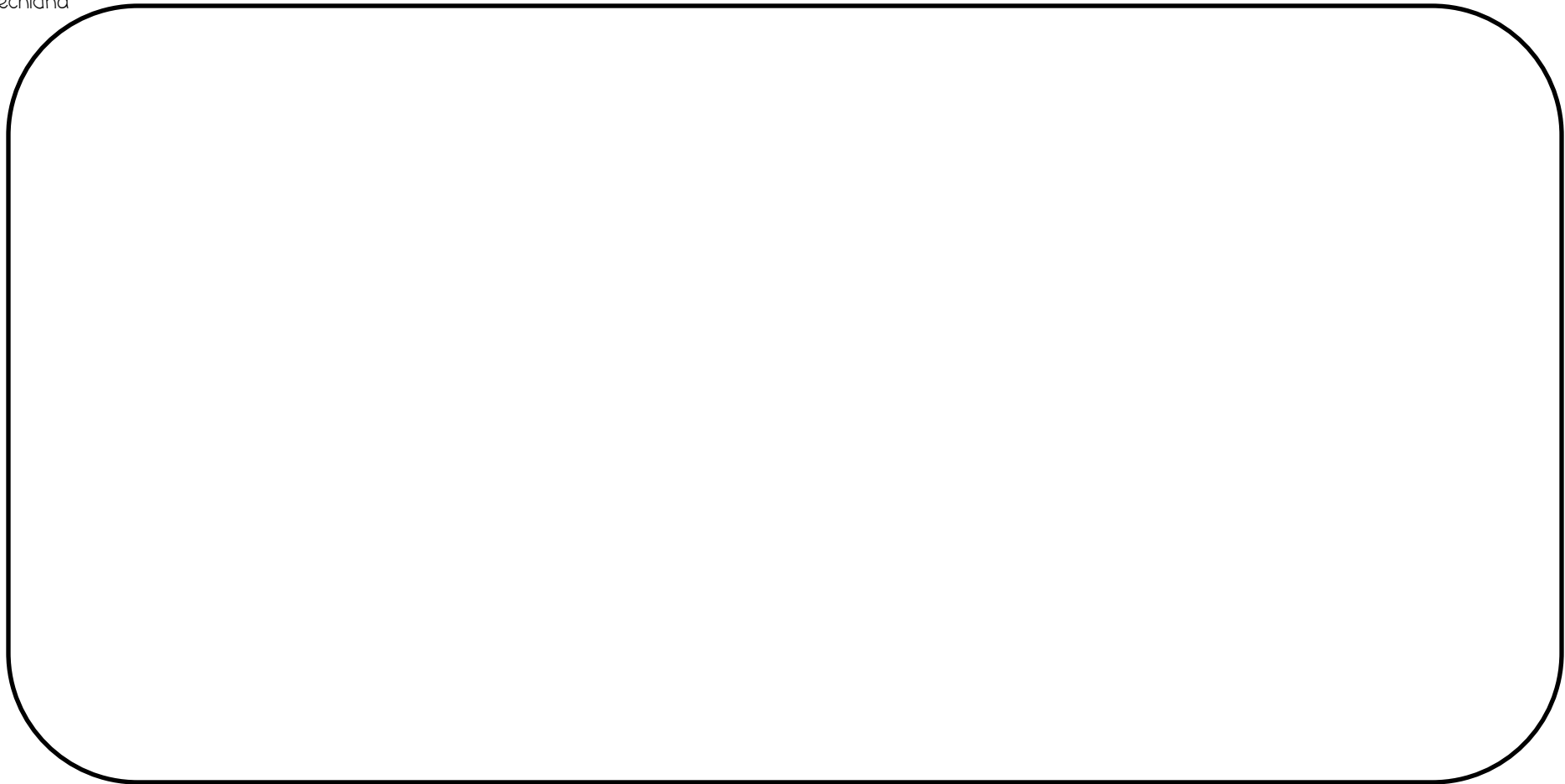
