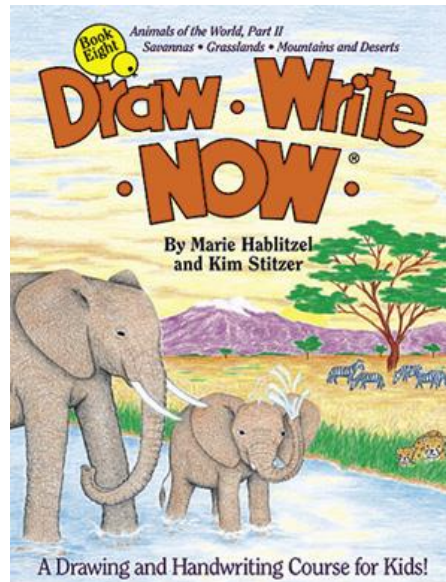

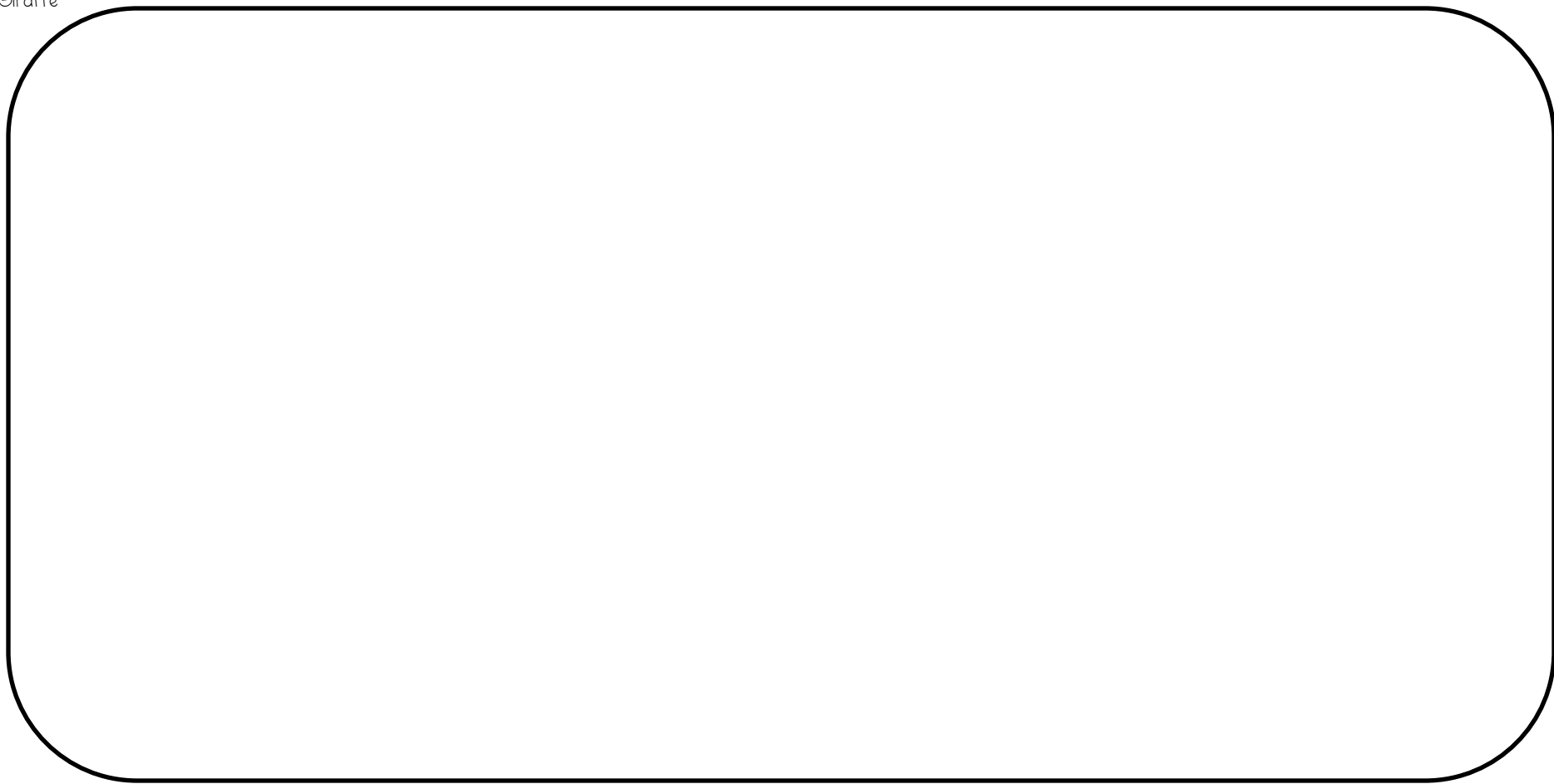

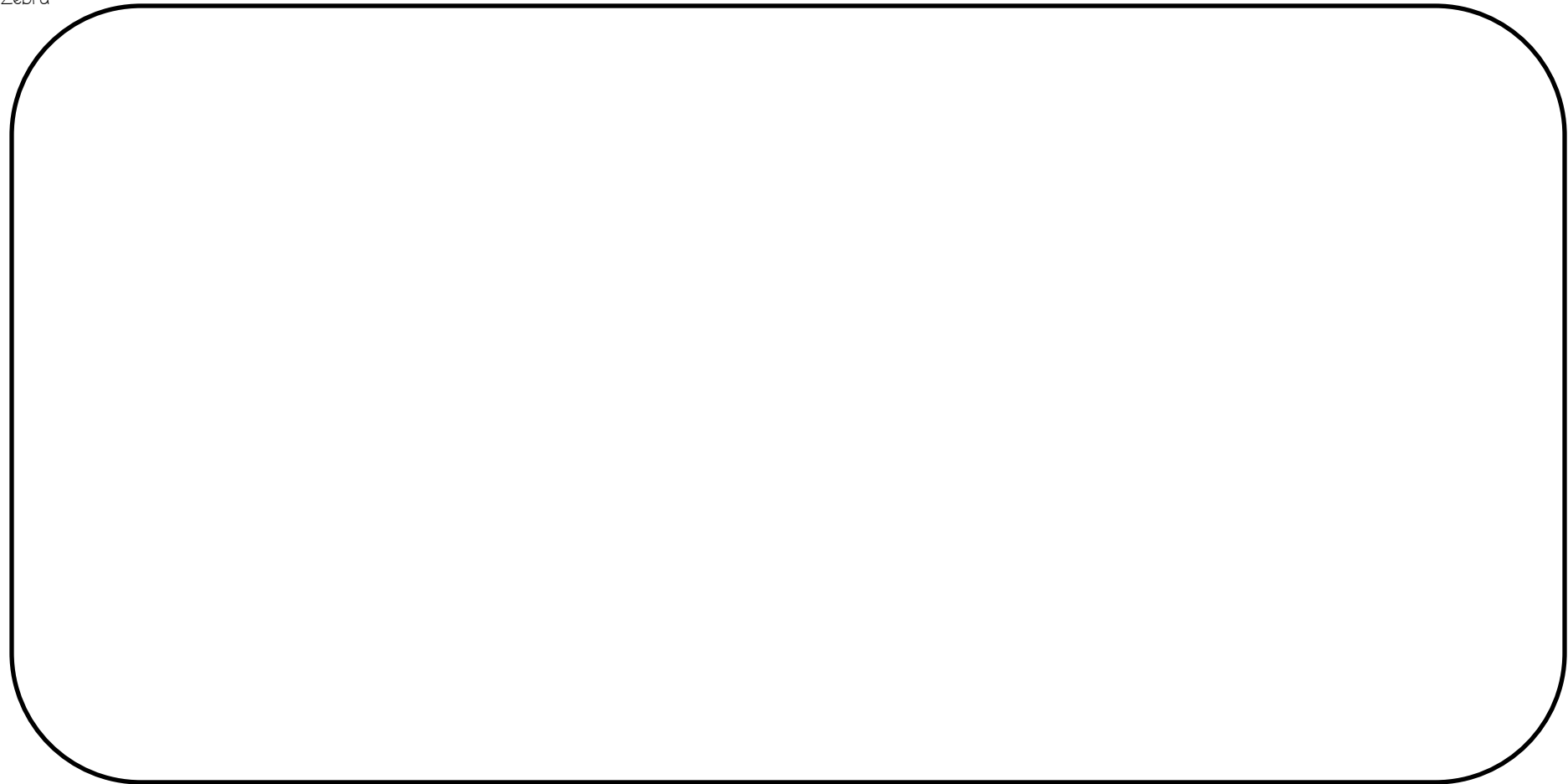
Giraffes live on the savanna. The weather is always warm. Giraffes reach for tree branches. They eat the leaves.

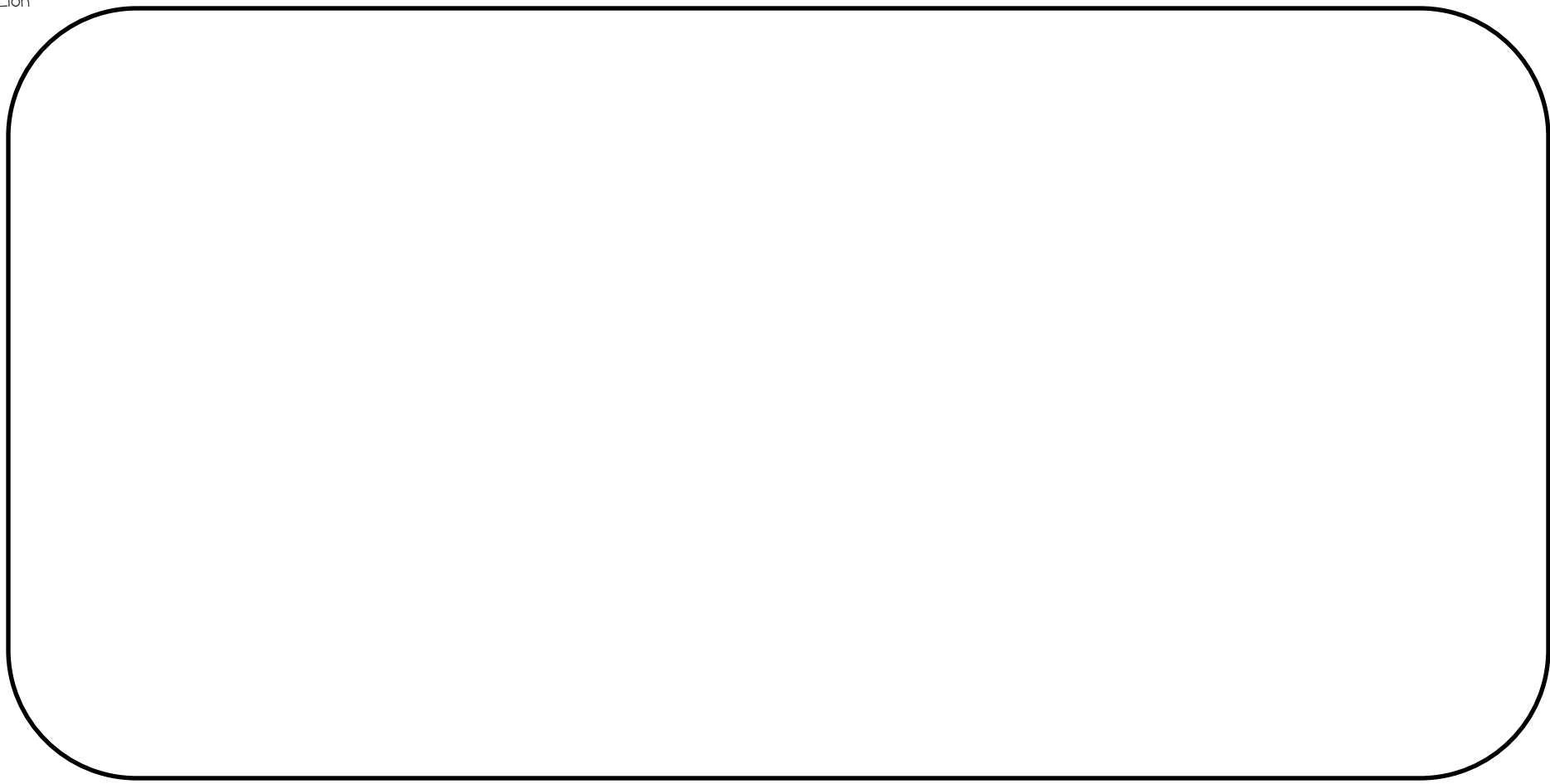


Hippos live in rivers and lakes.

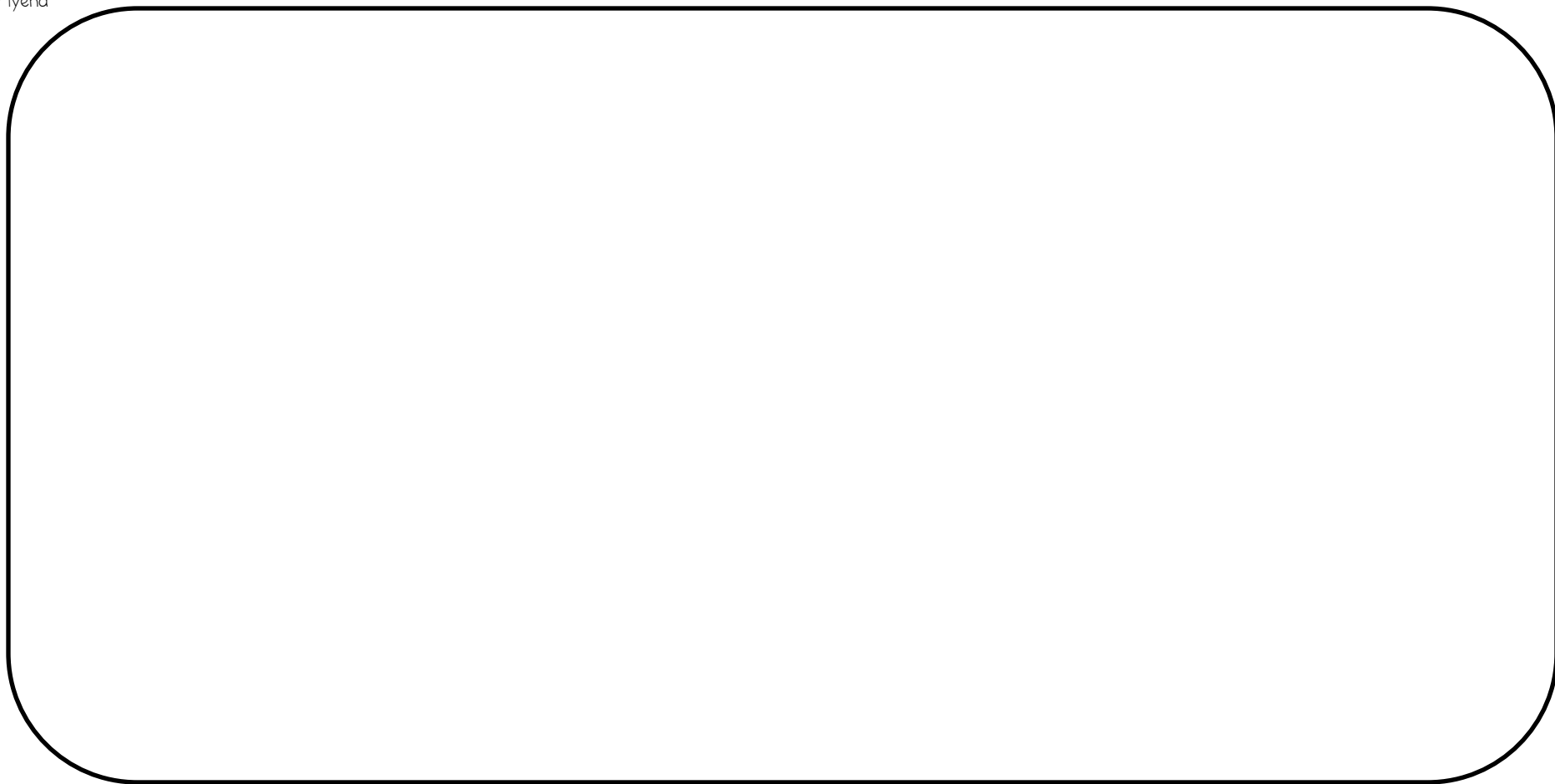


Lions are hunters. They wait near

fly

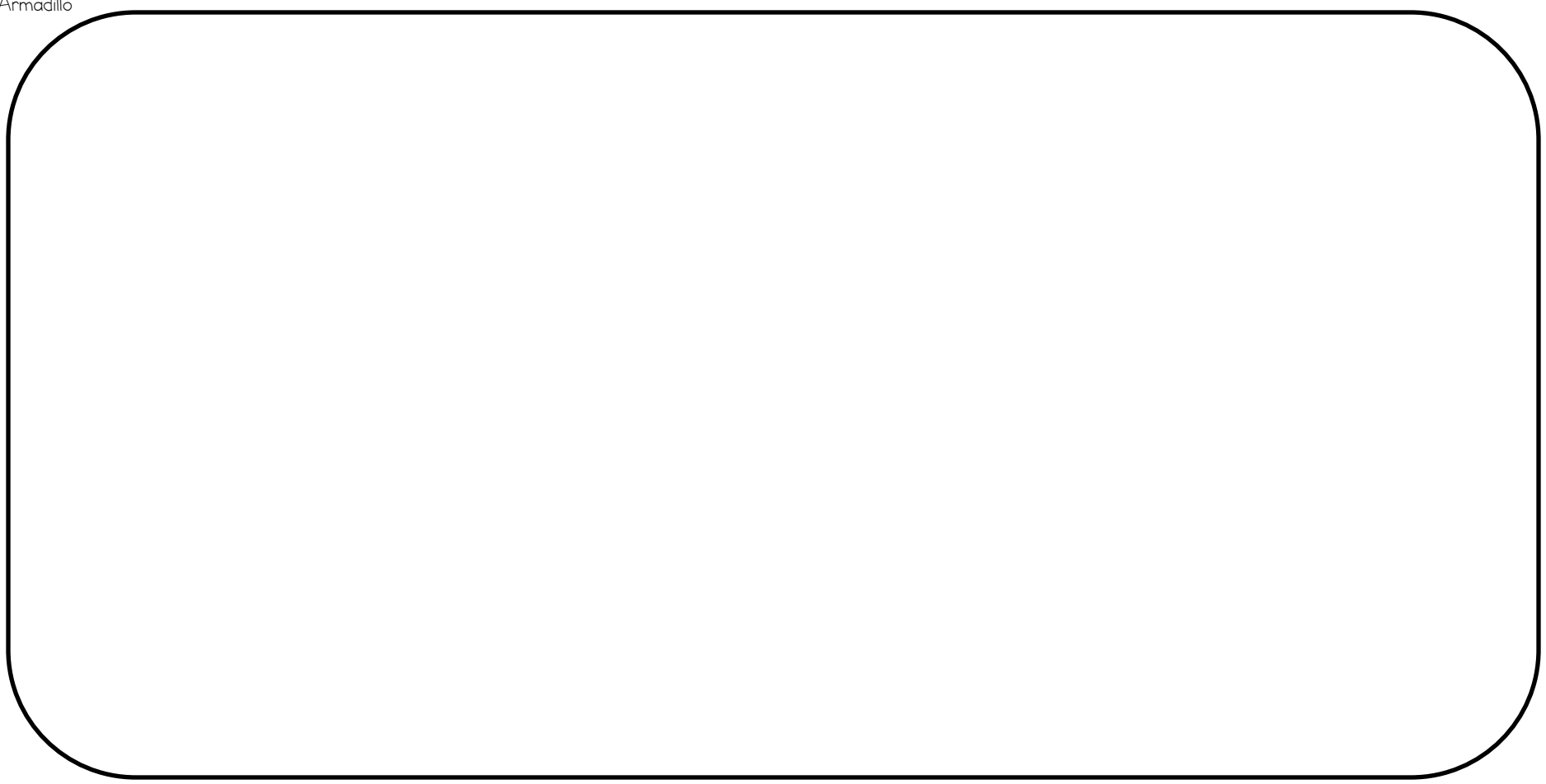
Rhinos live near pools and rivers.

a grassland.

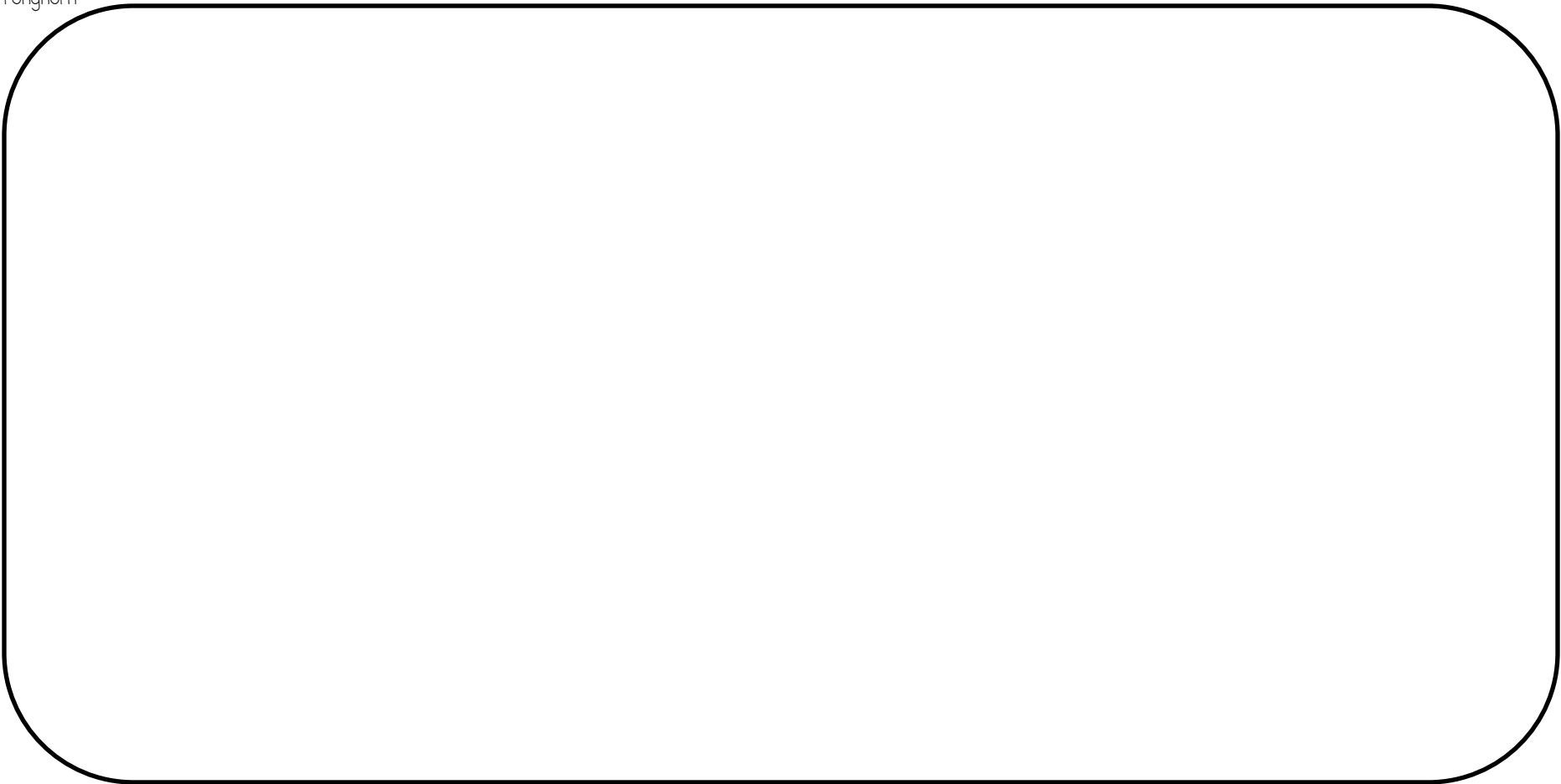


The armadillo lives on the prairie.

whistle after danger passes.

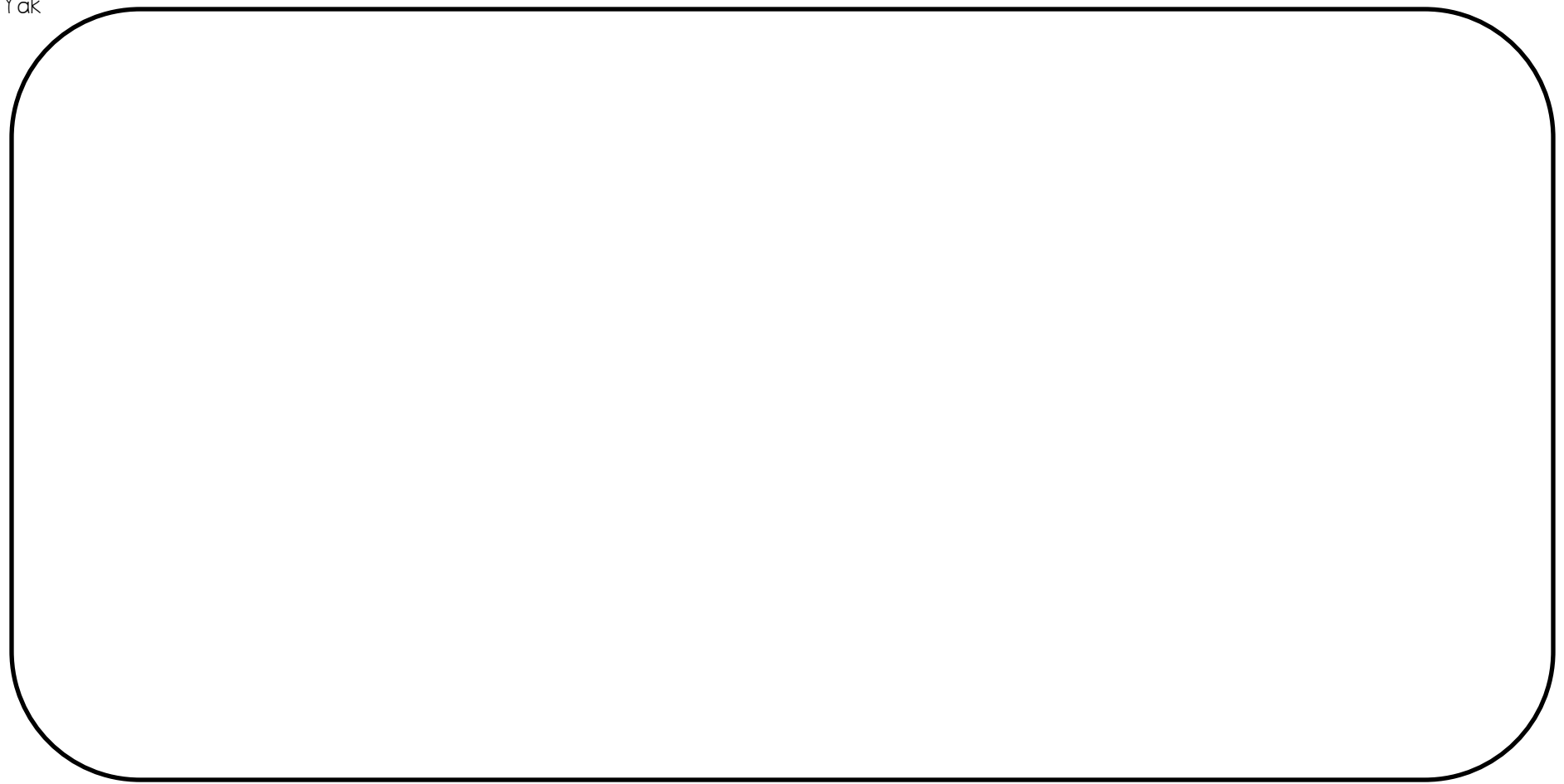
Pronghorns are hard to catch. They

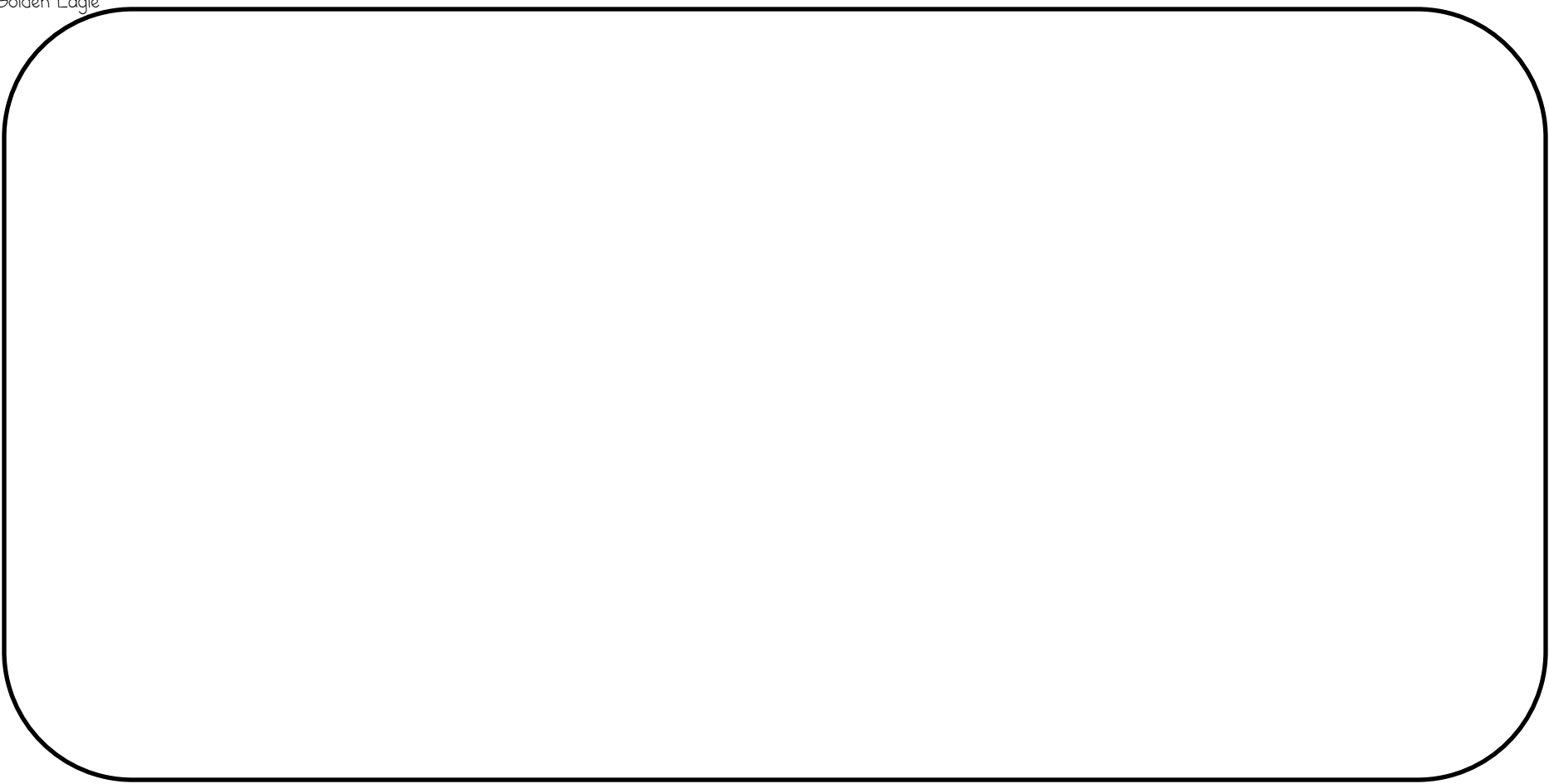


Yaks live on tall mountains. They

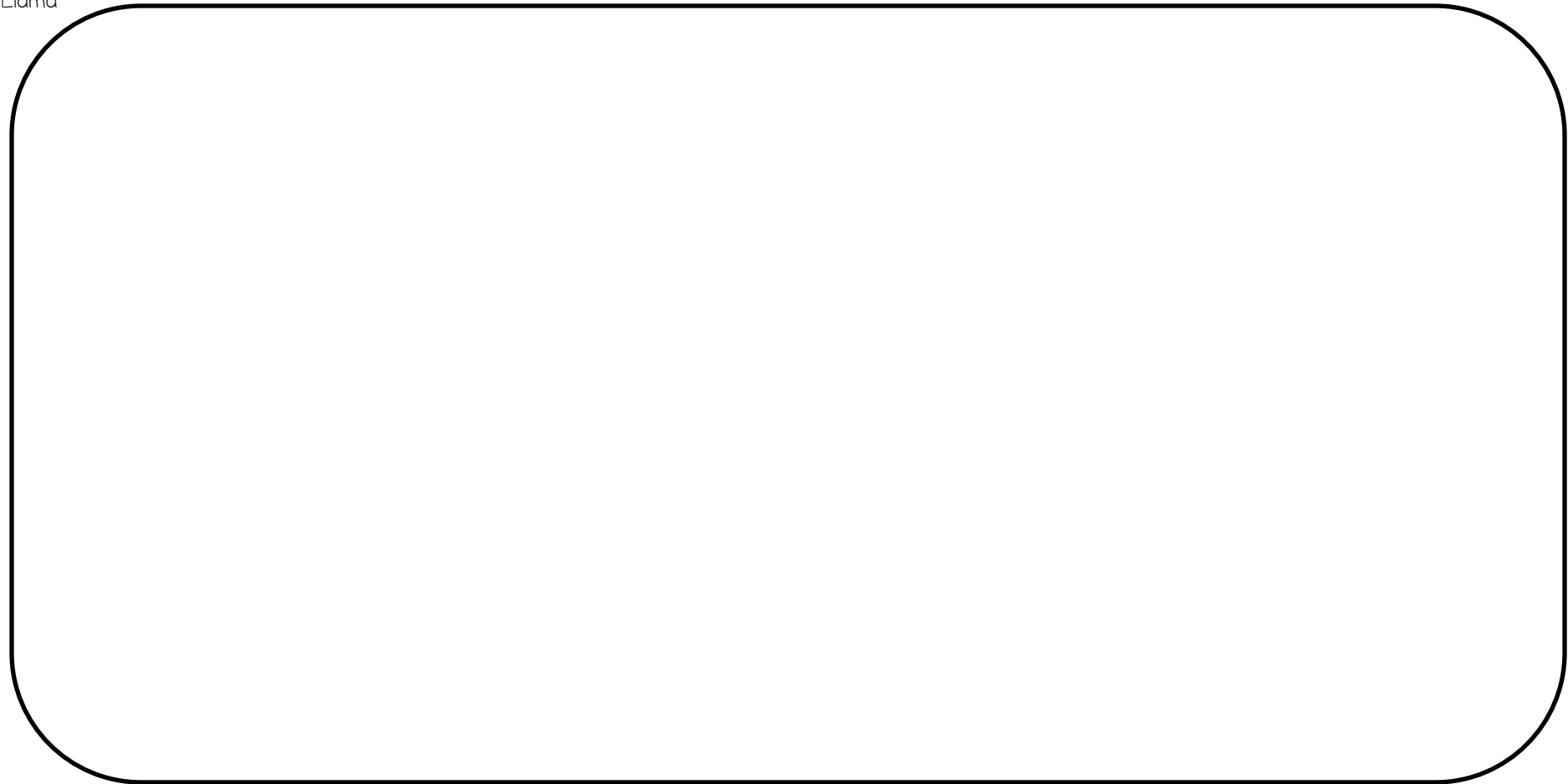

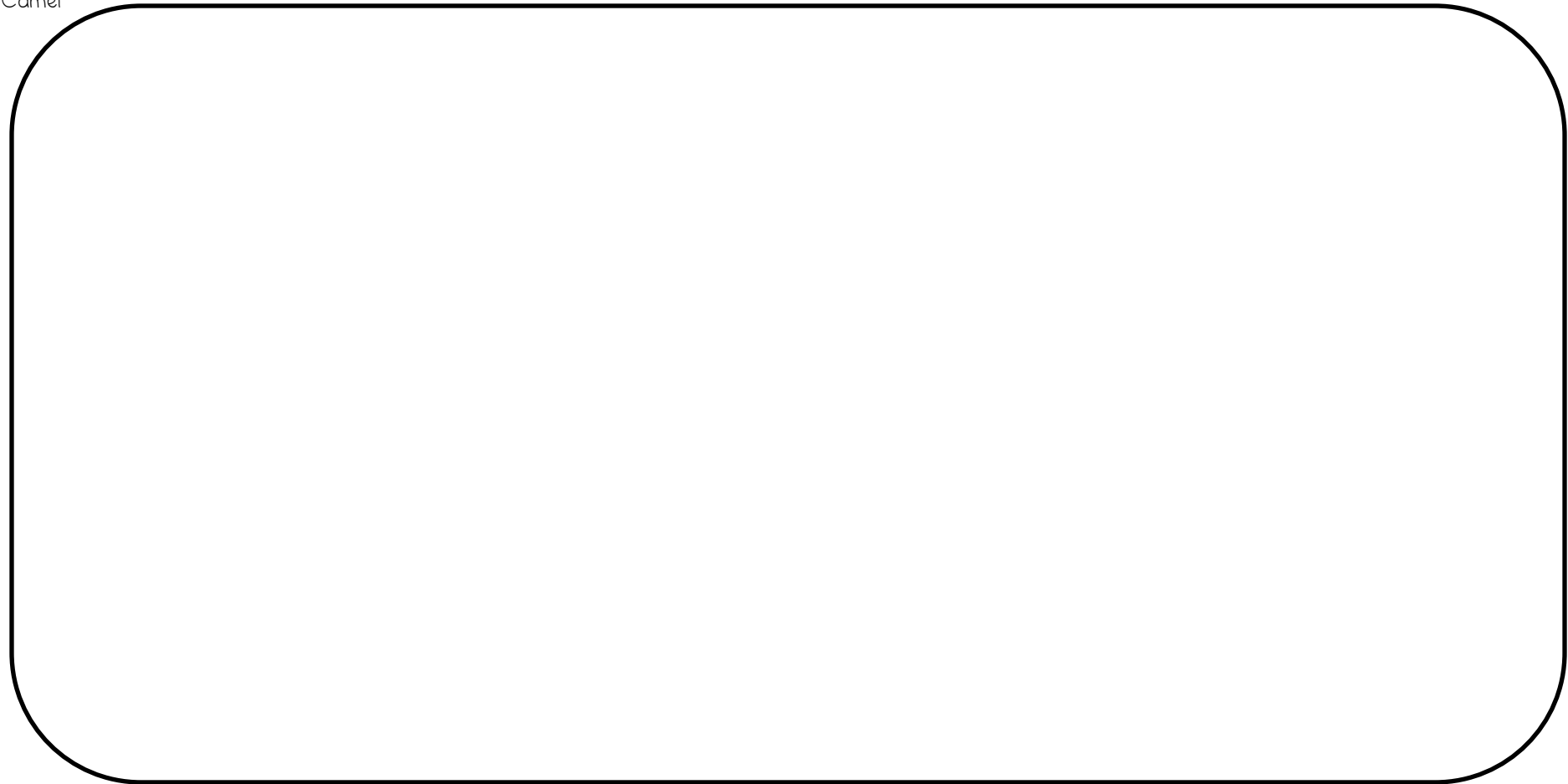

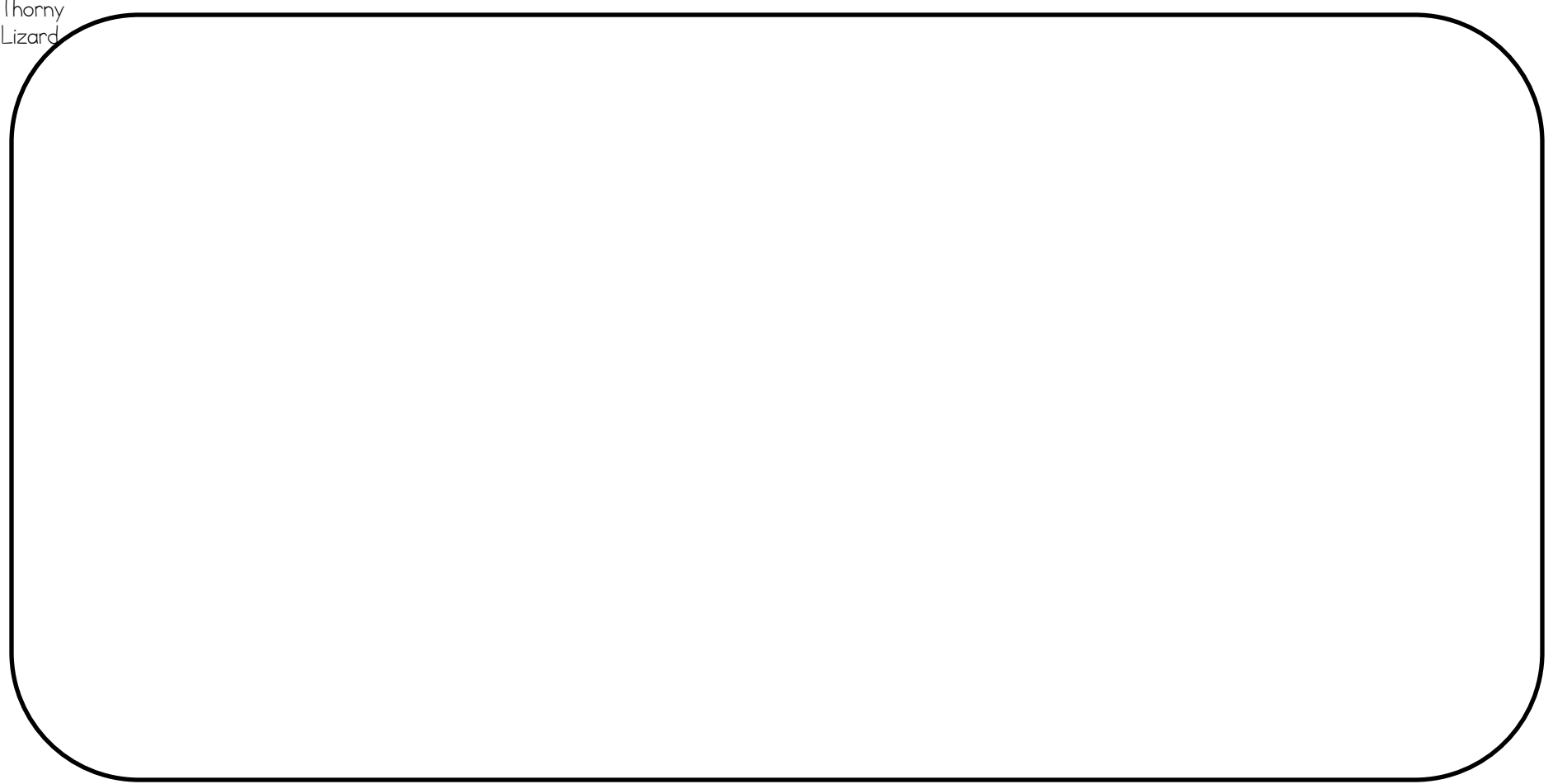
