
As your child grows, remove more pieces for an added challenge, until s/he is ready to put the entire folder together alone!




# The Jelly Bean Prayer




Red is for the blood He gave,




Green is for the grass He made.




Yellow is for the sun so bright,




Orange is for the edge of night.




Black is for the sins we made,




White is for the grace He gave.





Purple is for the hour of sorrow,
