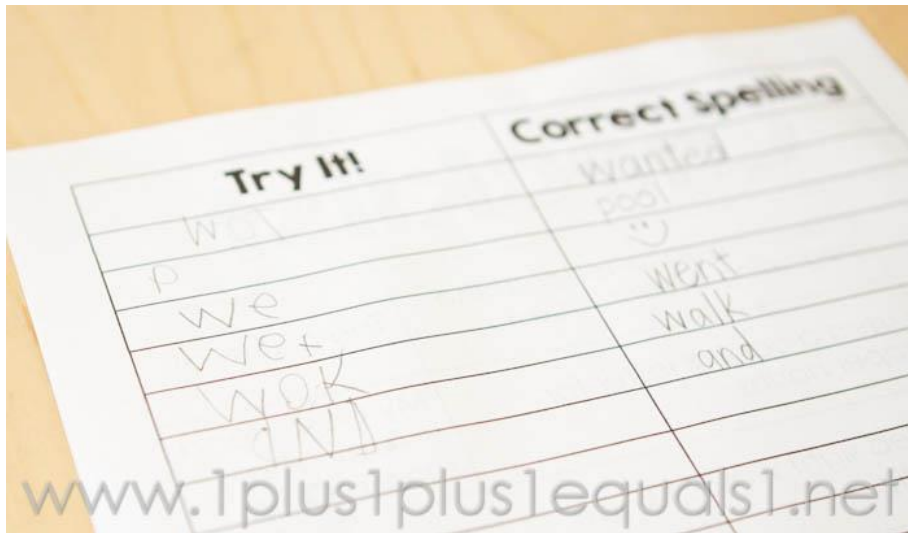

f-l-a-t

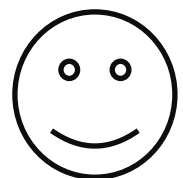
I left spaces between my words.
